DAILY UPDATE – E.COLI

As of 4 p.m. Friday, Oct. 24, there were 41 probable cases of E.coli 0157 reported to the San Diego County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA). The latest case is a second student from the Alpine School District. Most people who reported E.coli infection ate at Pat and Oscar's restaurants in Carlsbad (Palomar Airport Road and Plaza Camino Real), Mission Valley and El Cajon. The age range of cases is from 17 months to 84 years, with a total of four school-related cases of people who did not eat at Pat and Oscar's.

There will be NO UPDATES over the weekend unless there is a significant development. HHSA will continue to monitor the situation over the weekend. The next update, including any weekend updates, will be sent at 4 p.m. on Monday, Oct. 27.
