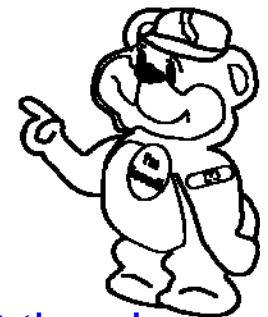


# San Diego County's Immunization Progress

● 73% (9 months of Calendar Year 1994), 76% (Fiscal Year July 1994-June 1995), 75% (Calendar Year 1995), 76% (Fiscal Year July 1995-June 1996) and 78% (Calendar Year 1996 and then Fiscal Year July 1996-June 1997) and 80% (Calendar Year 1997 and then Fiscal Year July 1997-June 1998), 80% (Calendar Year 1998), 78% (Fiscal Year July 1998-June 1999), 77% (Calendar Year 1999), 78% (Calendar Year 2000), 81% (Calendar Year 2001), 79% (2002), 83% (2003), 80% 2004: These statistics are from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), National Immunization Random Digit Dialing Survey (sample: N=440, age: 19-35.9 mos.).

● 69% (Spring/Summer 1995), 74% (Spring/Summer 1996), 80% (Spring/Summer 1997), 77% (Spring/Summer 1998), 87% (Spring/Summer 1999), 86% (Spring/Summer 2000) and 85% (Spring/Summer 2002), 89% (Spring/ Summer 2003), 86% (Spring/Summer 2004), 88% (Spring/Summer 2005): These statistics are from the County of San Diego Health and Human Services Agency Immunization Program Random Digit Dialing Survey (1995 sample: N=400; 1996 sample: N=420; 1997 sample: N=622; 1998 sample: N=780; 1999 sample: N=812; 2000 sample: N=795; 2003 sample: N=902; 2004 sample: N=899; 2005 sample: N=839; age for all surveys: 19-35.9 mos.)

◆ 53% (1989), 70% (1990), 60% (1991), 63% (1992), 65% (1993), 66% (1994), 67% (1995), 67% (1996), 72% (1997), 75% (1998), 75% (1998), 77% (1999), 78% (2000), 80% (2001): These statistics are from kindergarten retrospective surveys conducted by the County of San Diego Health and Human Services Agency. The surveys assessed kindergarten records looking back in time to when these children were two years old. For example, the 1990 rate of 70% reflects 1993 survey results. Thus, 70% of children who turned two in 1990 were fully immunized. (1989-91 sample: N=450 average; 1992-2000 sample: N= >2000 average; 2001 sample: 4,647.)

▲ 51% (1987): This statistic is from a CDC retrospective first grade survey of children who turned two years old in 1987.
