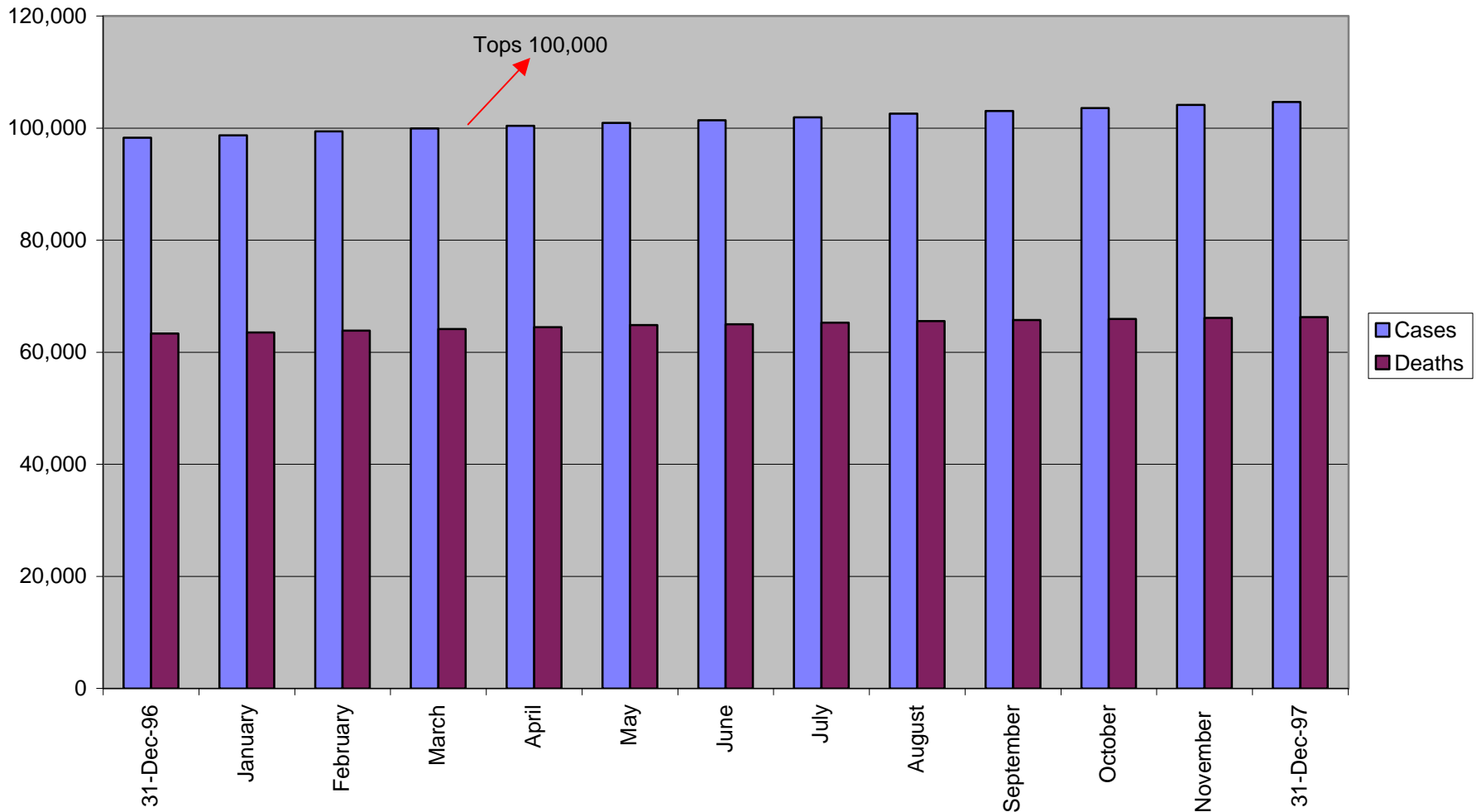

# 1997 AIDS Cases and Deaths\*

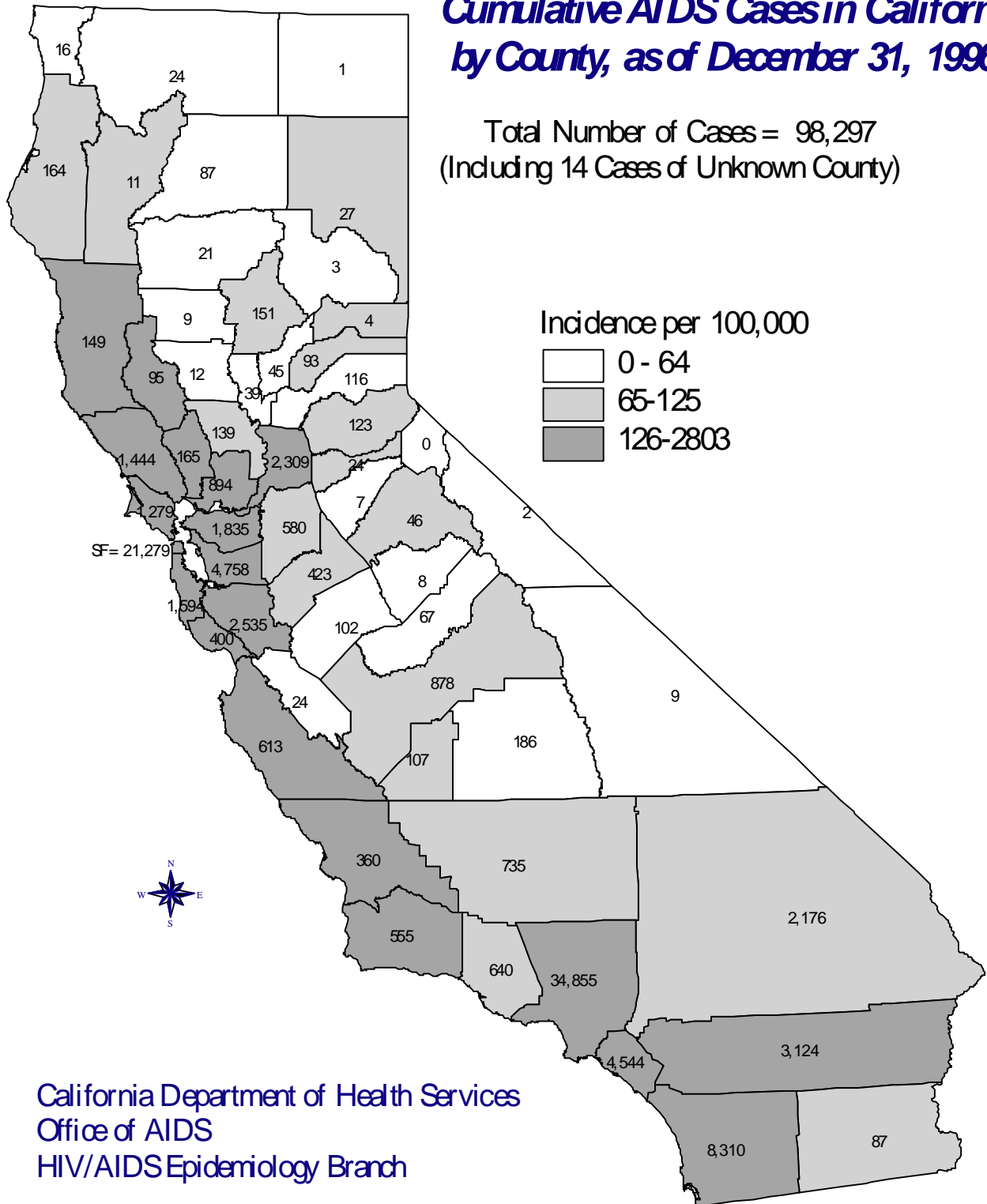


by Month

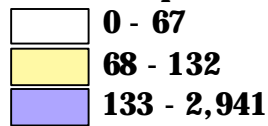

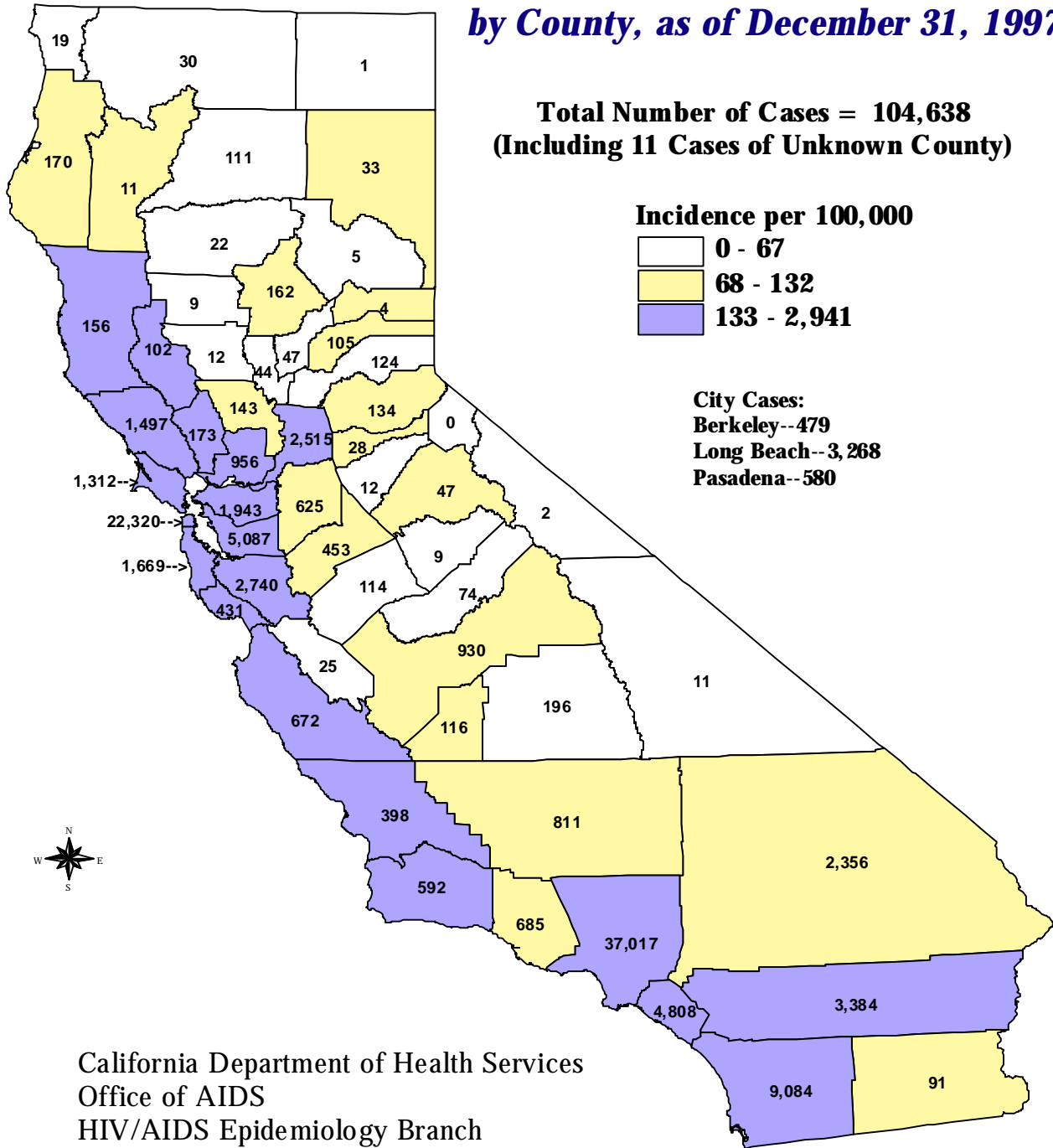
### Cumulative AIDS Cases in California by County, as of December 31, 1997
