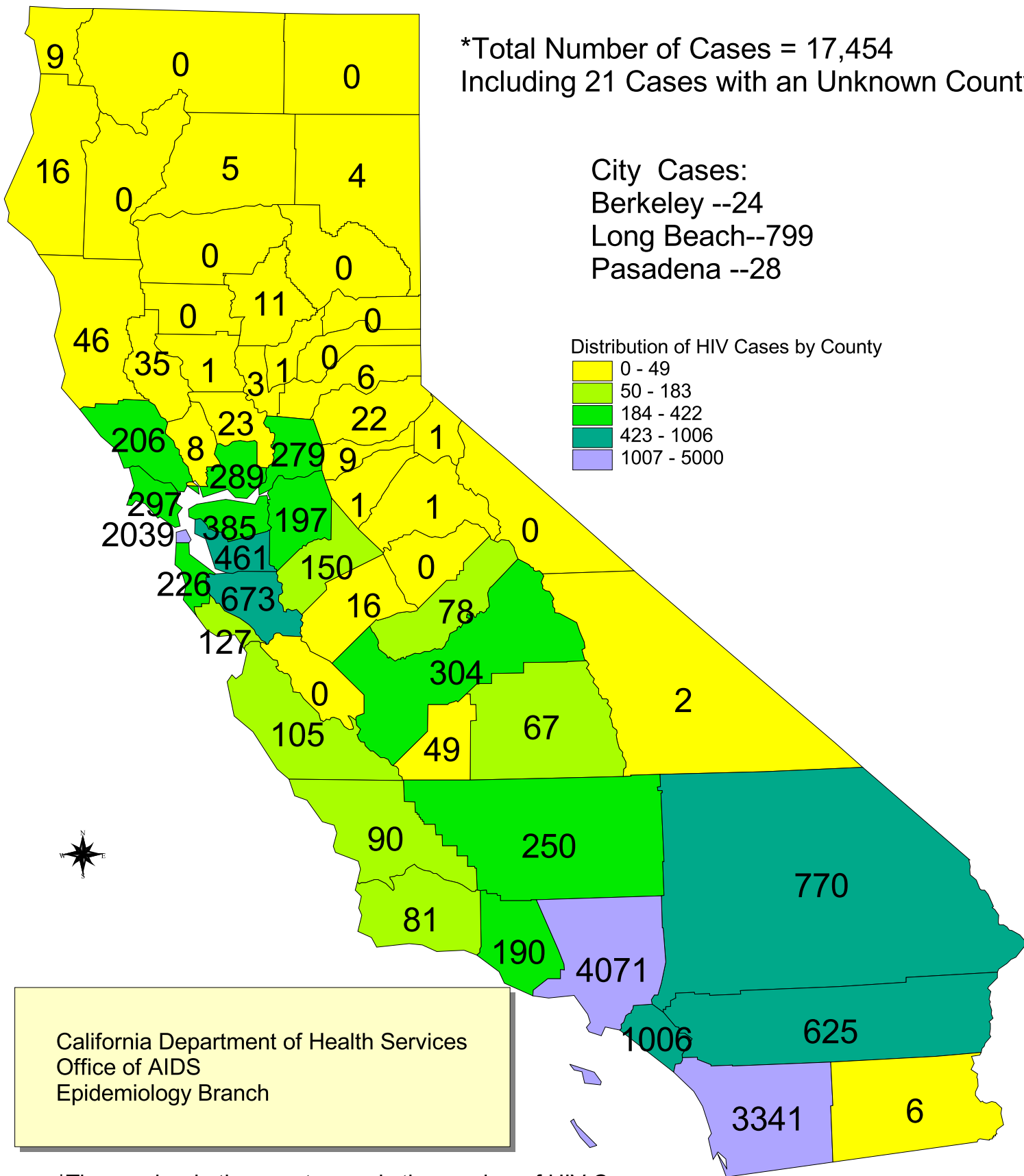
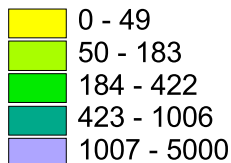

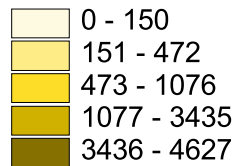

Cumulative HIV Cases in California by County, as of May 30, 2003

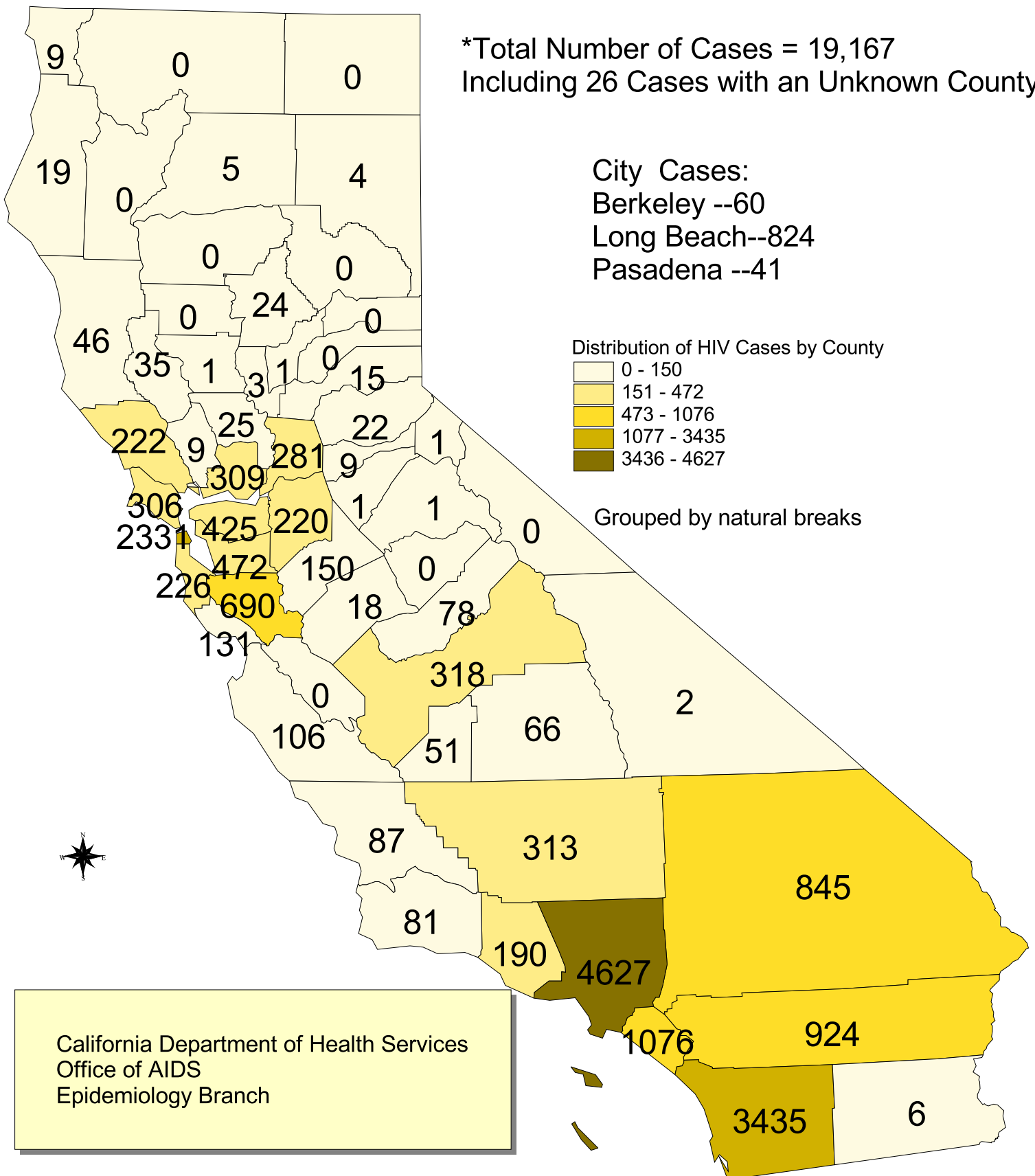

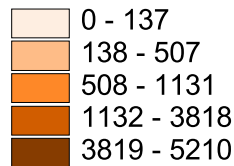

Cumulative HIV Cases in California by County, as of June 30, 2003

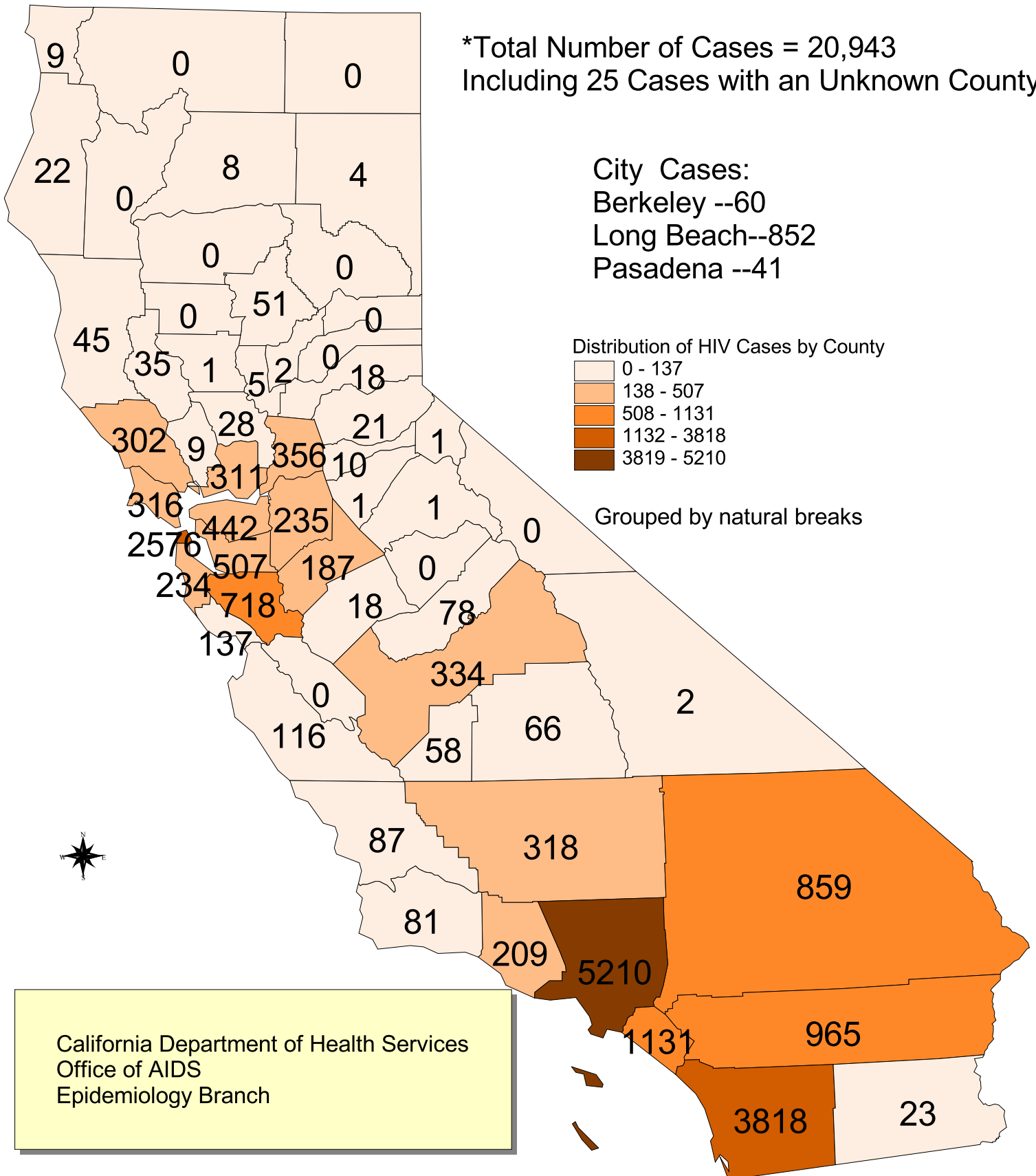

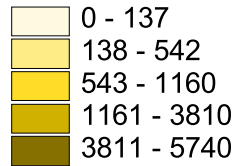

Cumulative HIV Cases in California by County, as of July 31, 2003

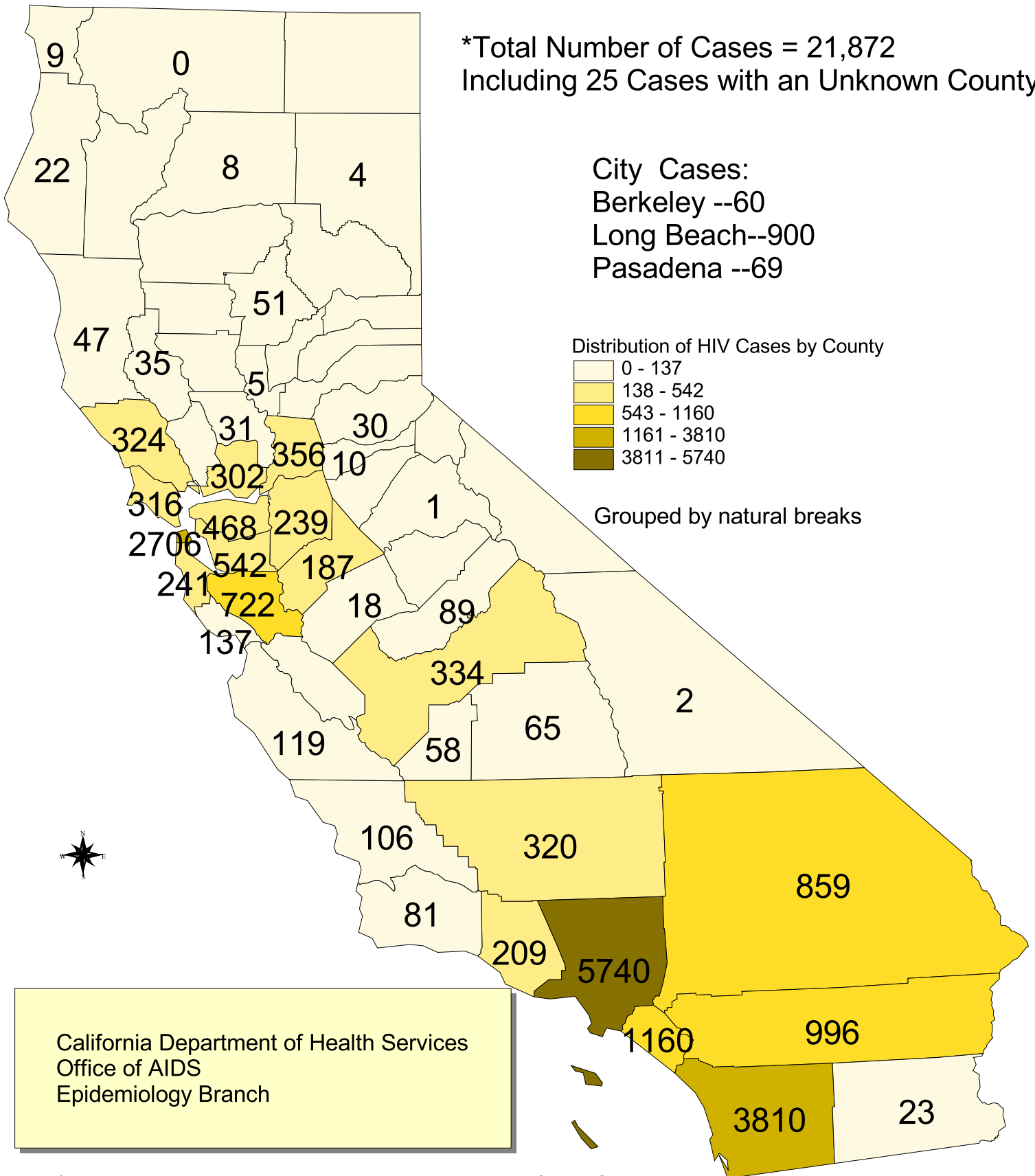

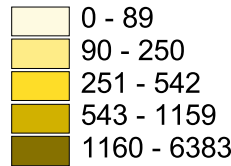

Cumulative HIV Cases in California by County, as of August 31, 2003

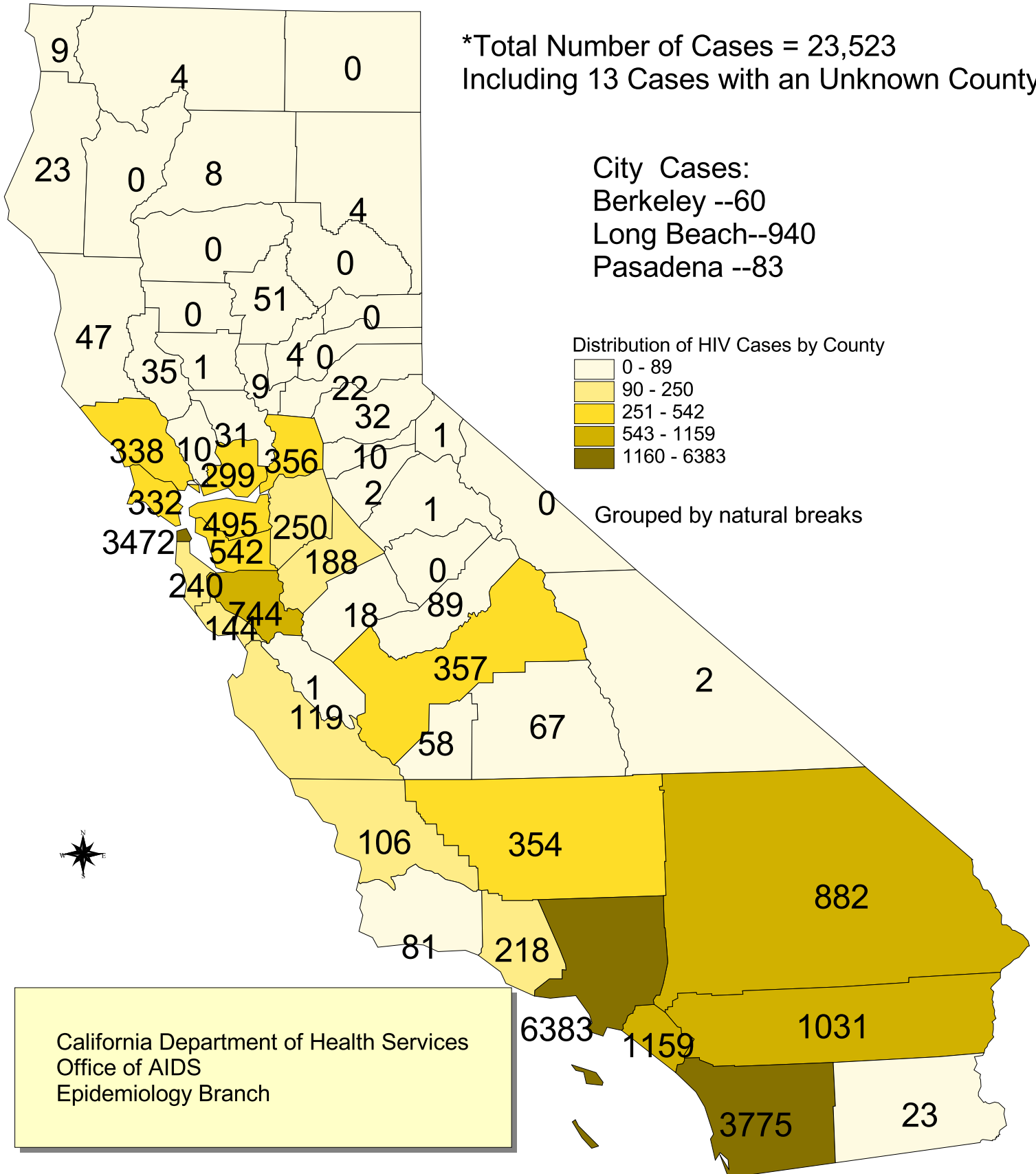

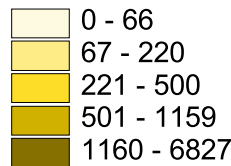

Cumulative HIV Cases in California by County, as of September 30, 2003

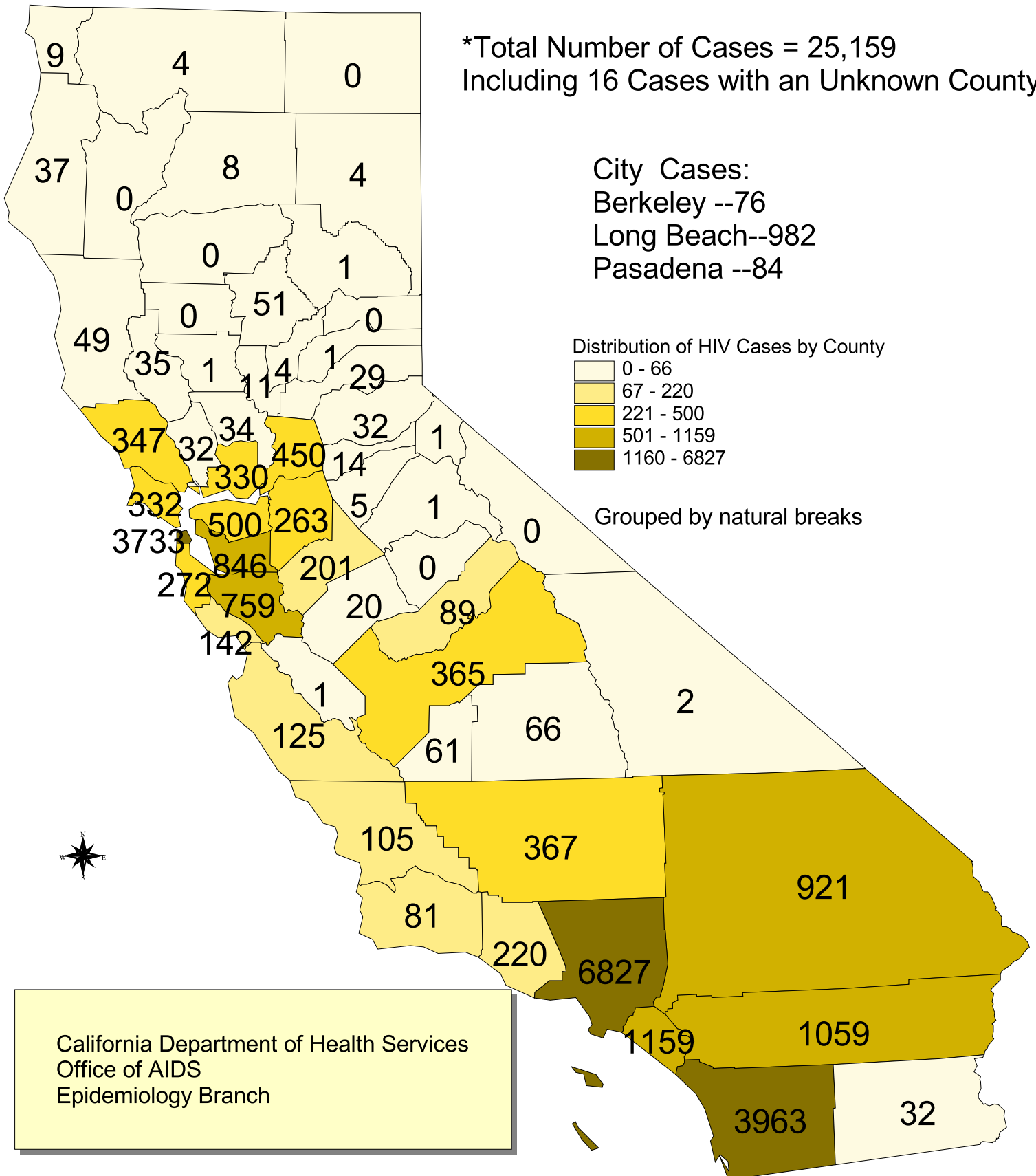

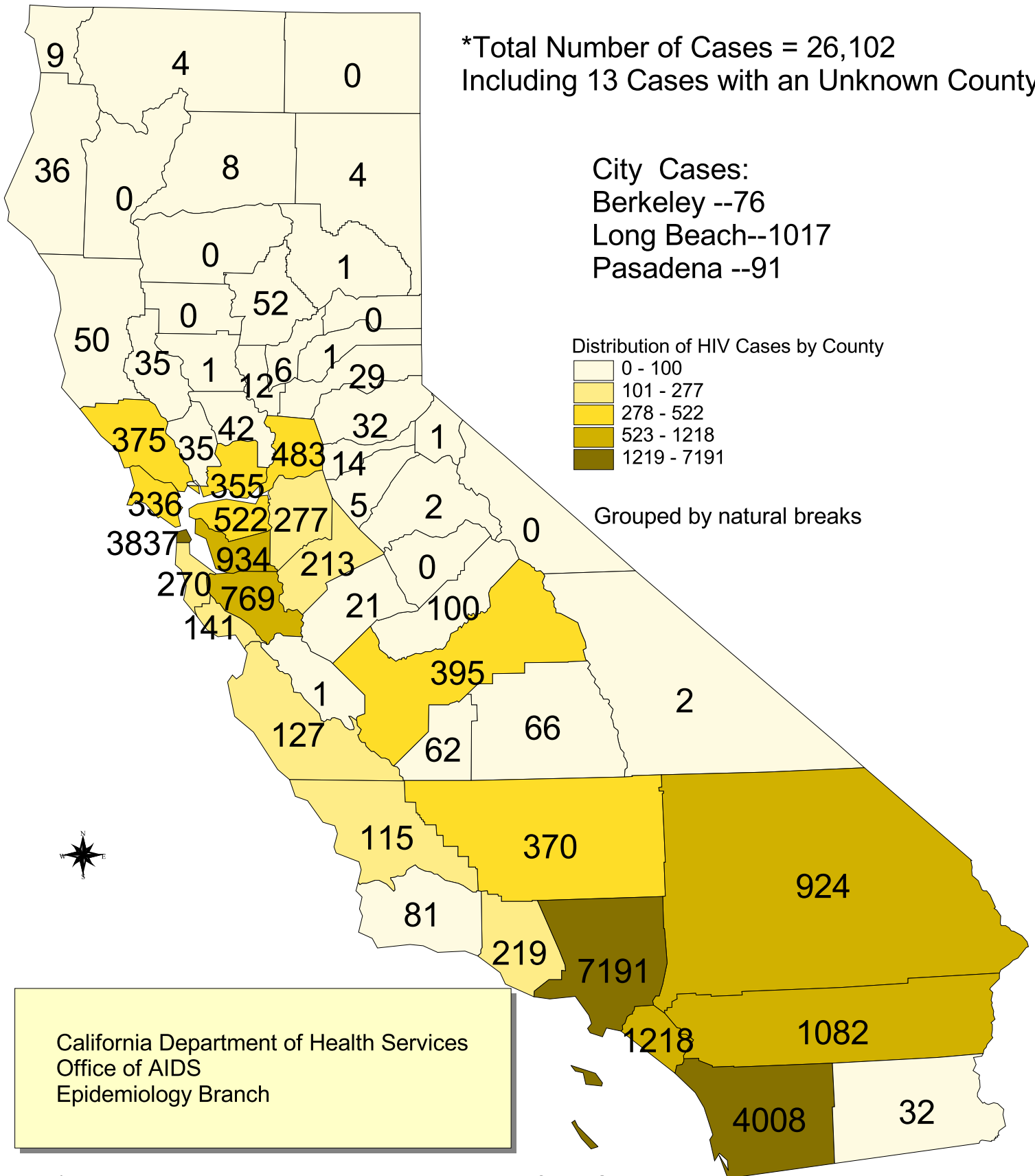

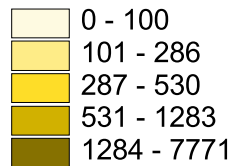

Cumulative HIV Cases in California by County, as of November 30, 2003

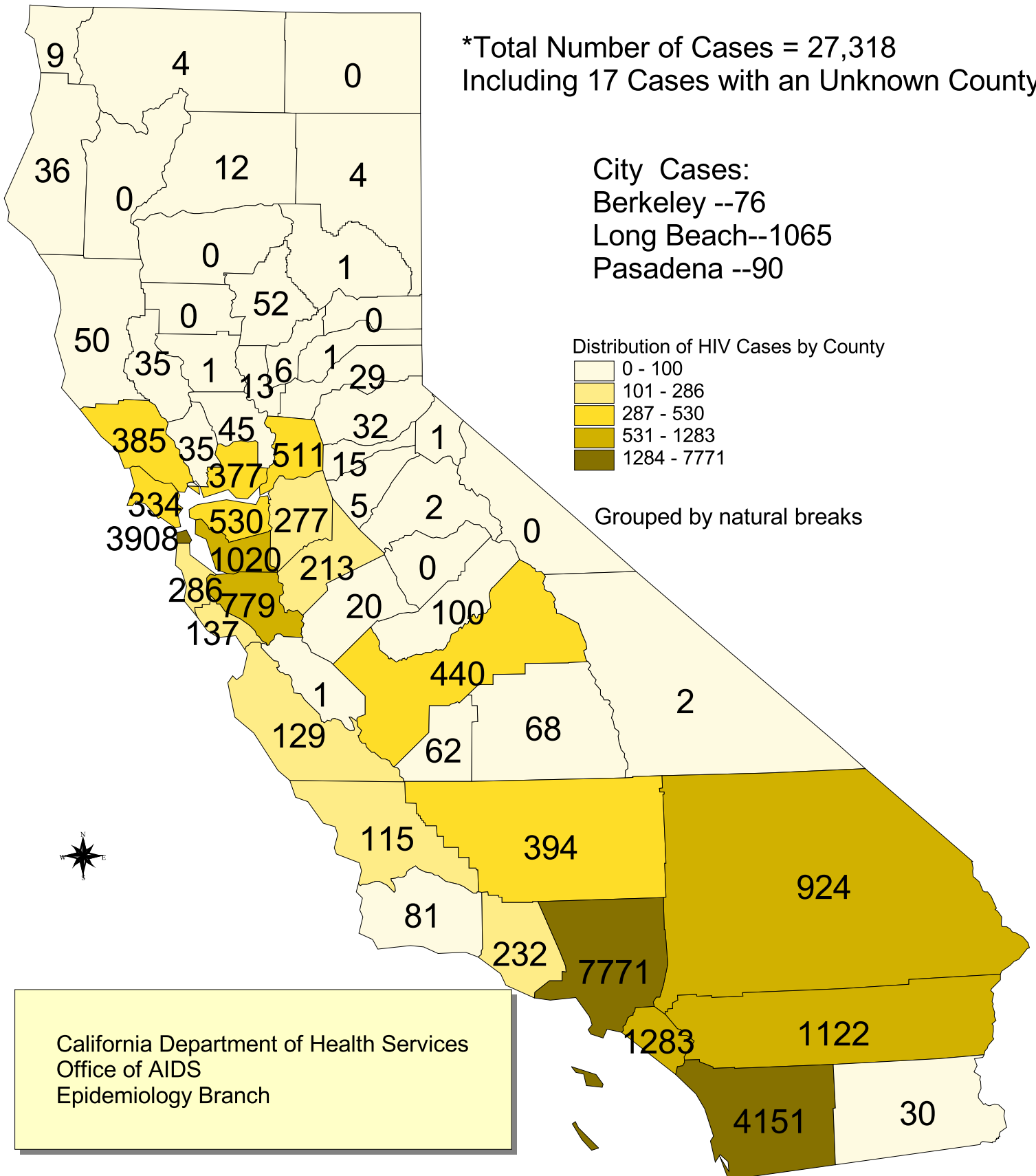

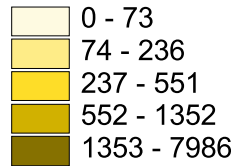

Cumulative HIV Cases in California by County, as of December 31, 2003

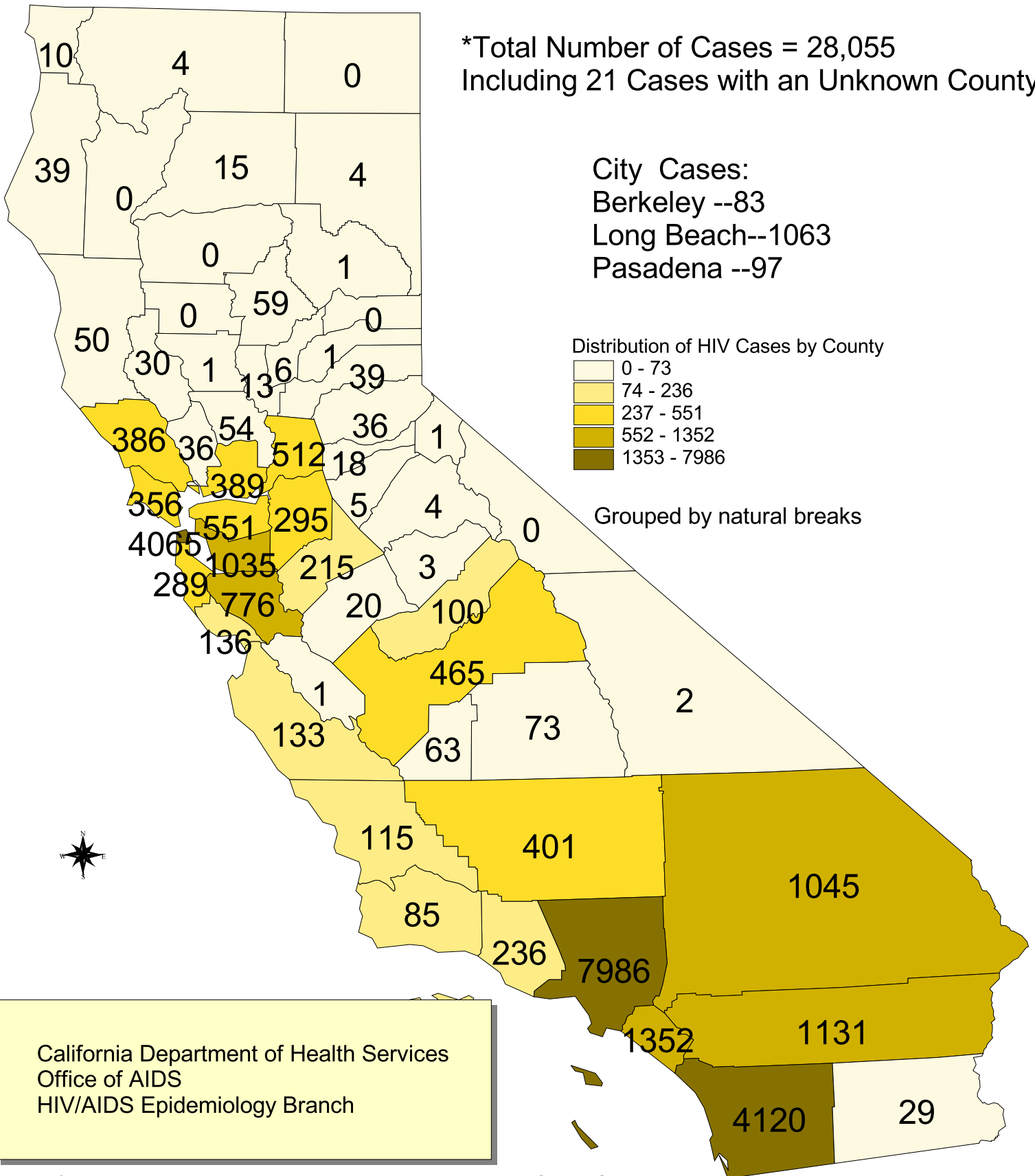
