BOIL WATER ORDER AND PUBLIC NOTIFICATION LIFTED FOR PINE VALLEY BIBLE CONFERENCE CENTER WATER SYSTEM

Test Results Show Bacteria Absent in Drinking Water Supply

The County of San Diego, Department of Environmental Health (DEH) has lifted the Boil Water Order and Public Notification for the Pine Valley Bible Conference Center, located at 8668 Pine Creek Road, Pine Valley, CA 91962 effective immediately.

The water system previously tested present for total coliform bacteria. Total coliform bacteria can come from soils and other sources in the environment and can indicate a problem with the water supply system. The Boil Water Order was issued to ensure all water used is free from contamination.

The water system was disinfected and flushed and retested under the guidance of a Certified Water Distribution Operator. The five follow-up samples are **absent** for total coliform bacteria. The water is now free to be consumed without boiling first.
