Emergency Department (ED) Data is based on principal diagnosis and uses ICD-9 CM codes. ED discharges are those patients treated and discharged from the ED. 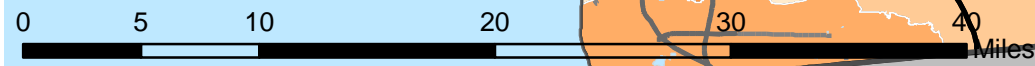
