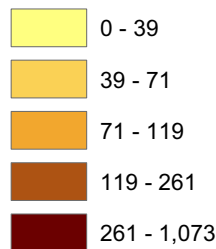


AIDS PREVALENCE RATES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF FEBRUARY 28, 2005

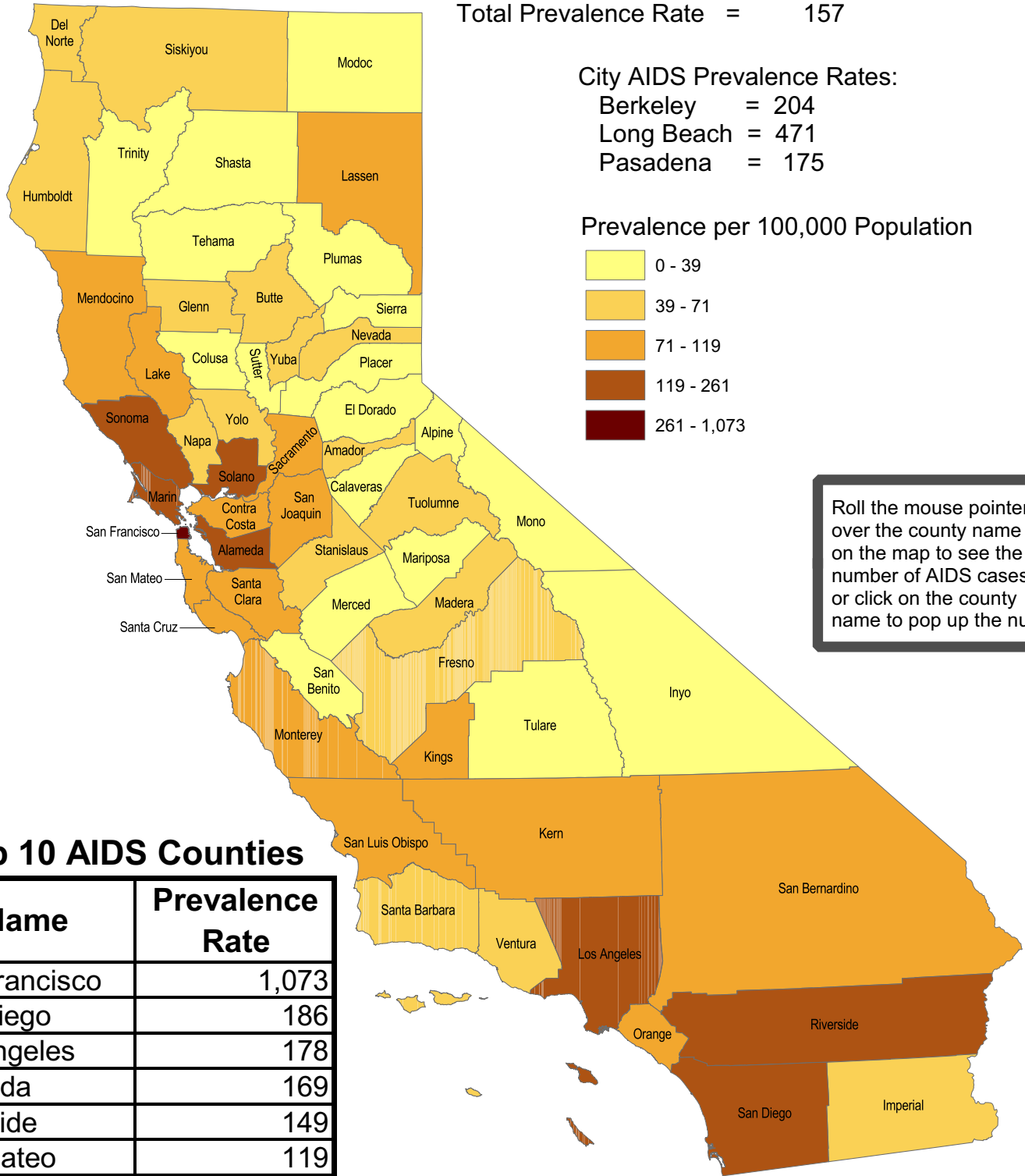
