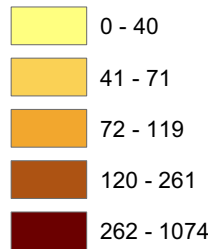


AIDS PREVALENCE RATES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF MARCH 31, 2005

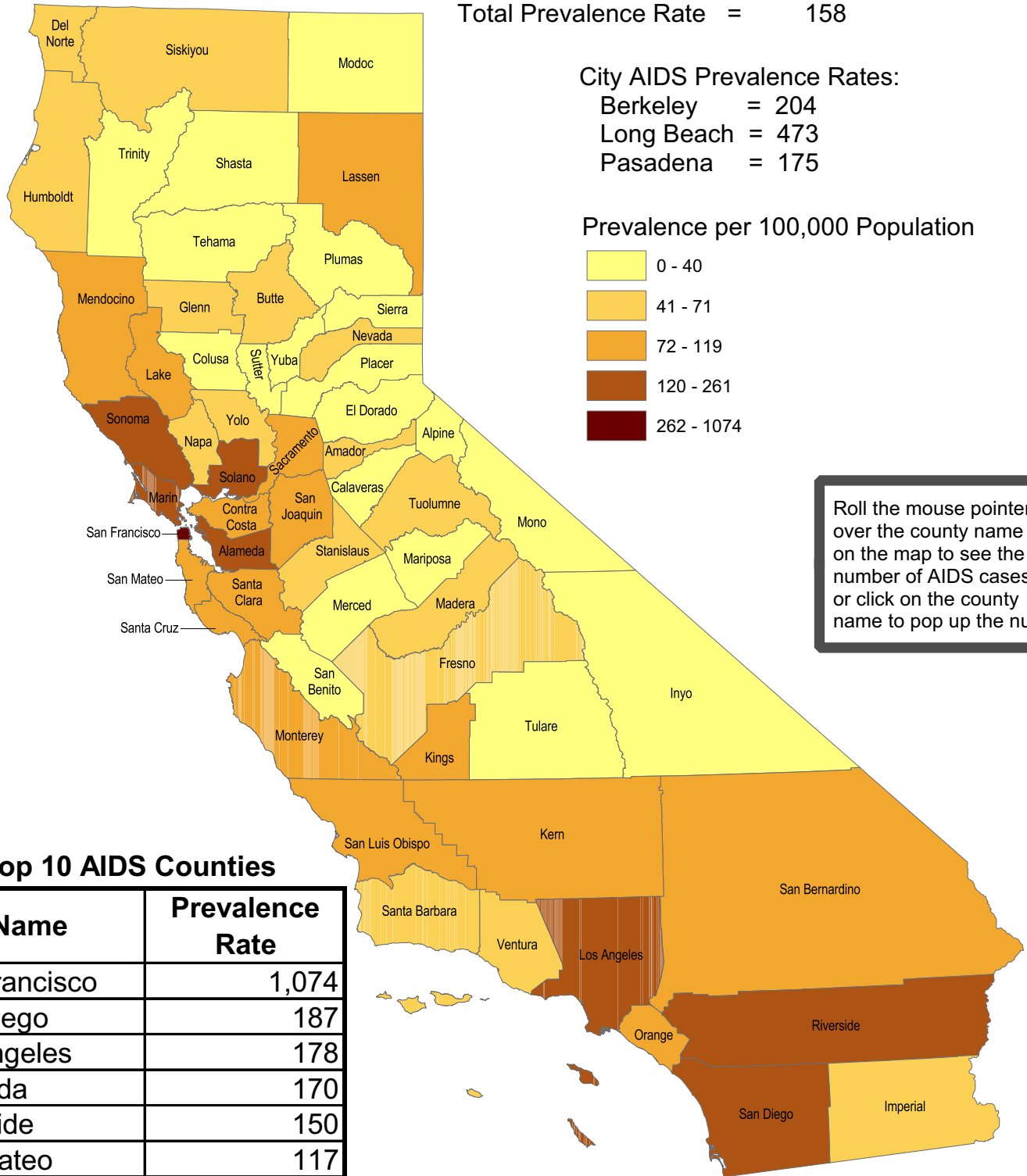
