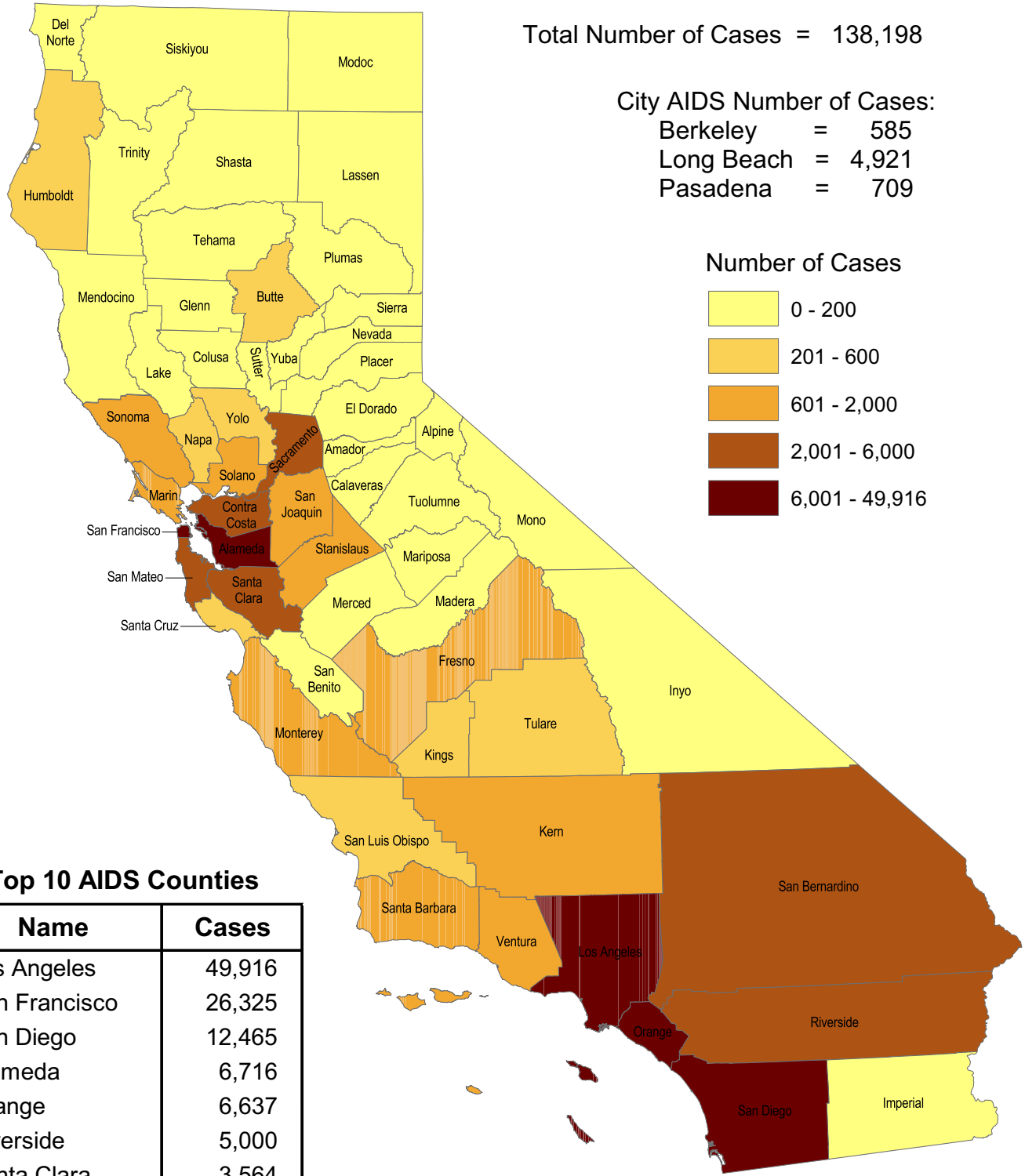

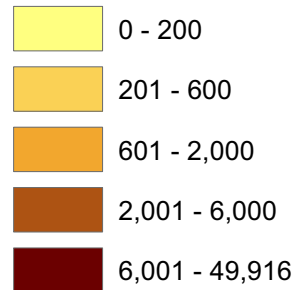
AIDS CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF AUGUST 31, 2005
