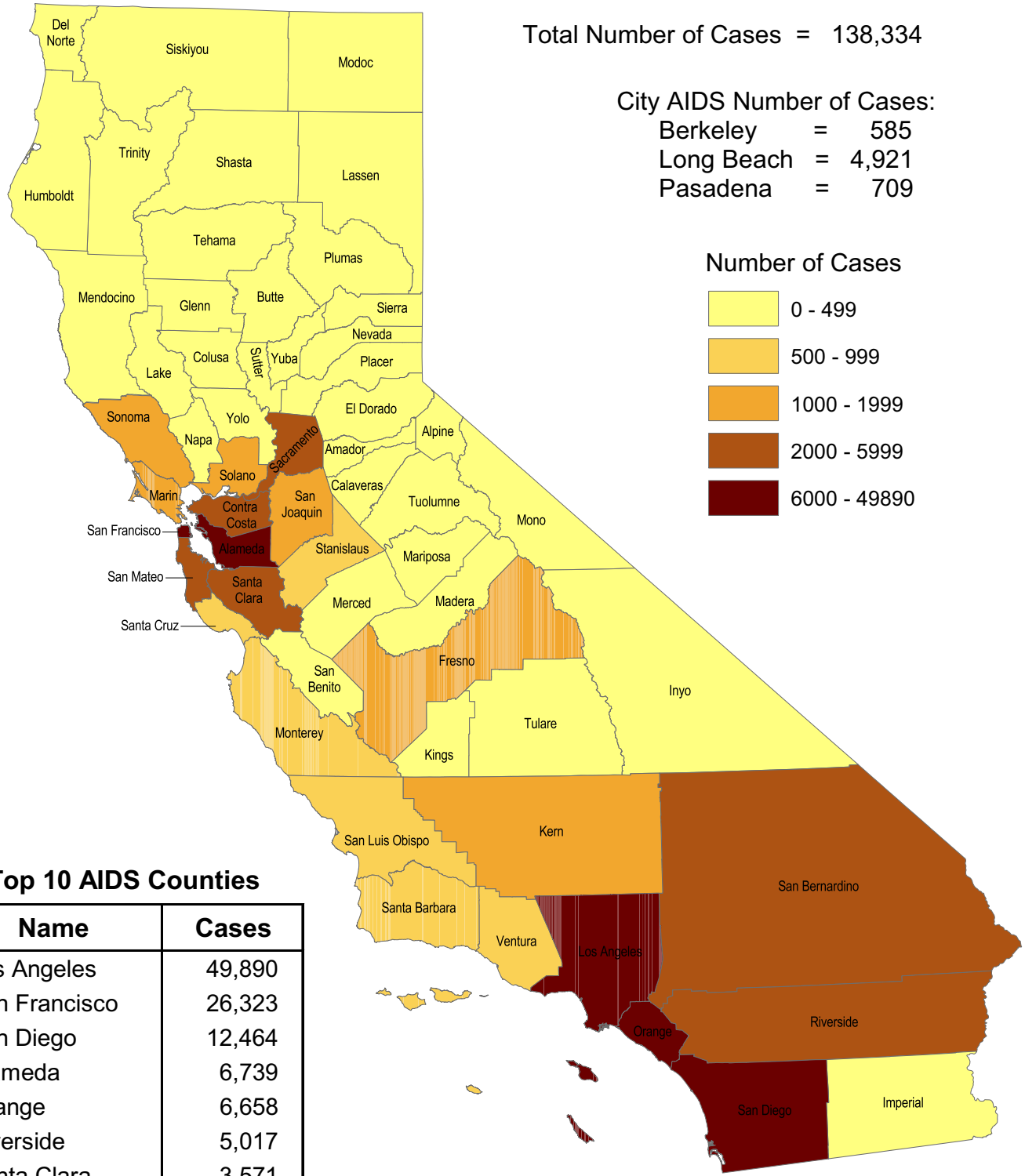

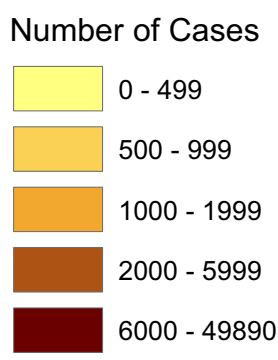


AIDS CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2005
