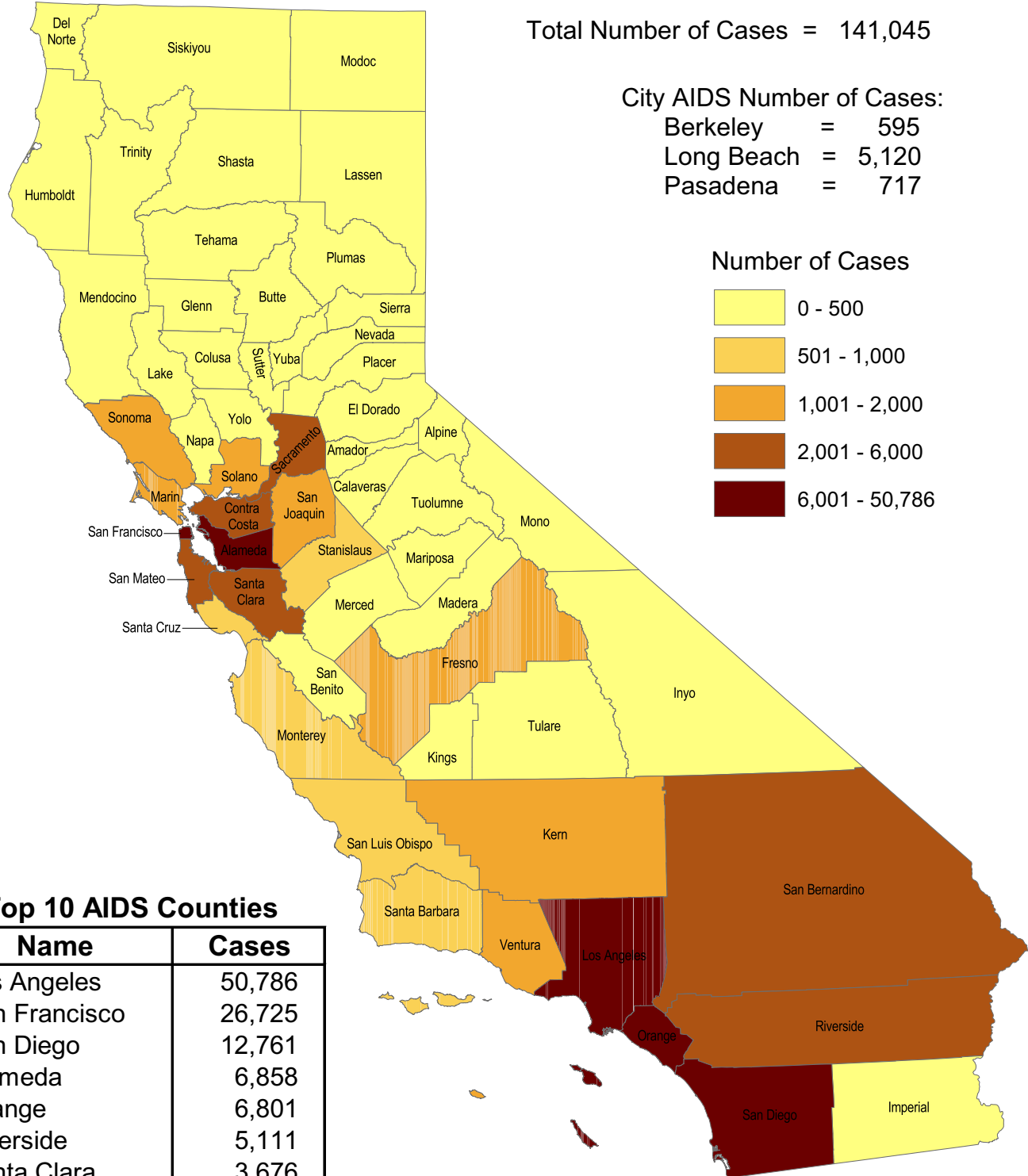


# AIDS CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF MAY 31, 2006

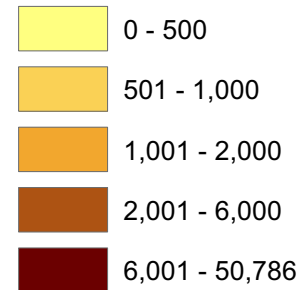
