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# AIDS CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF OCTOBER 31, 2006

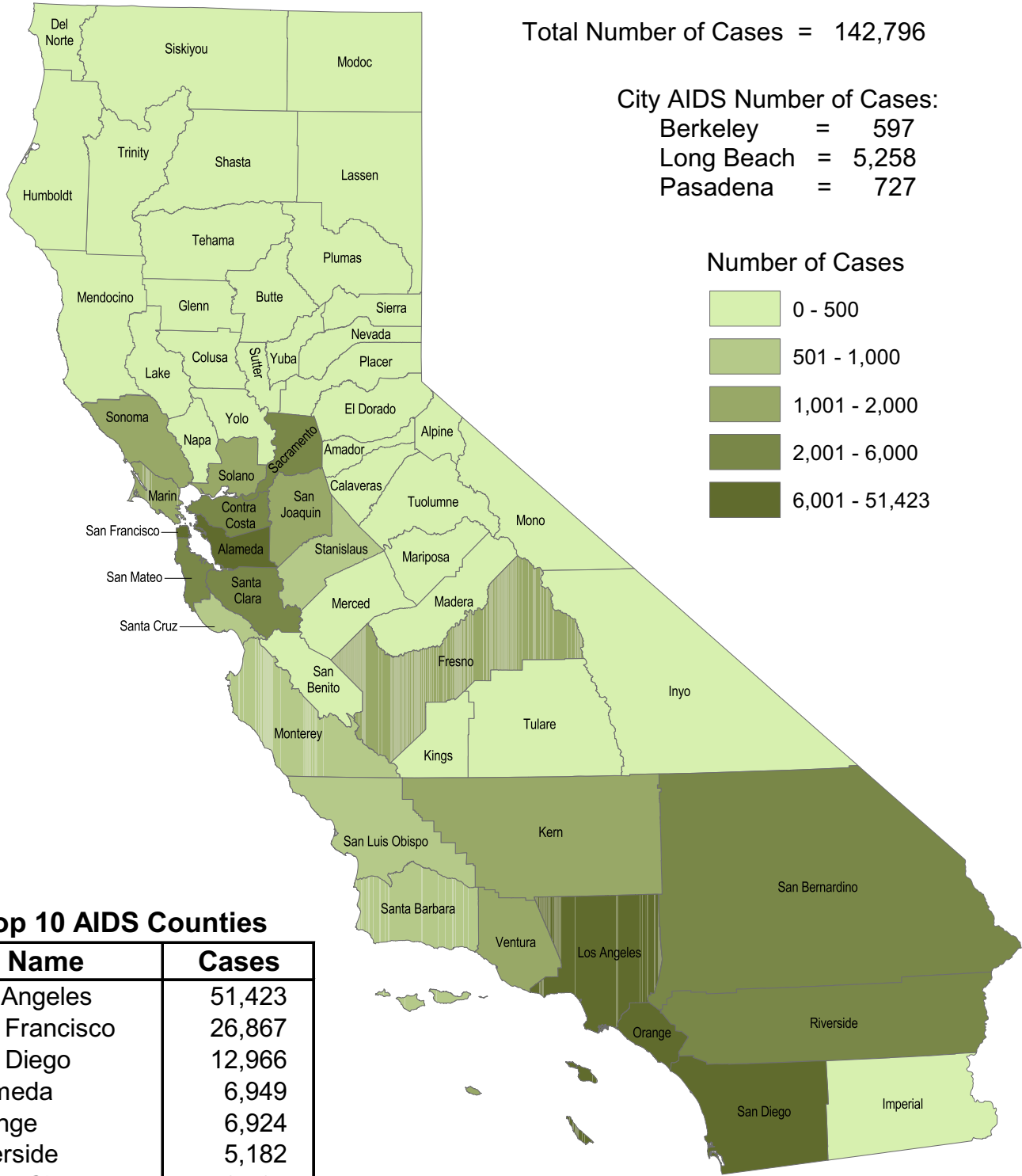
