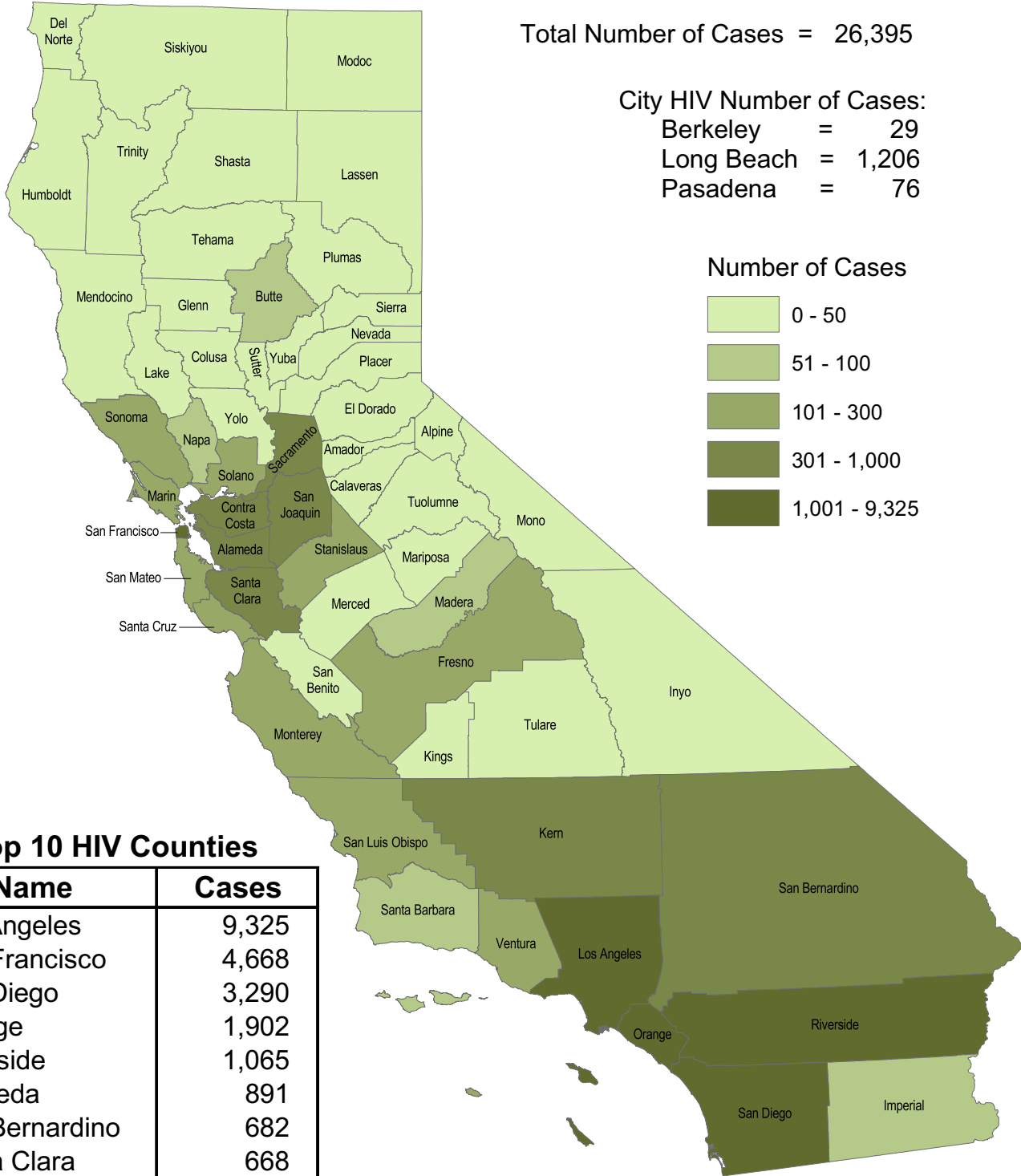

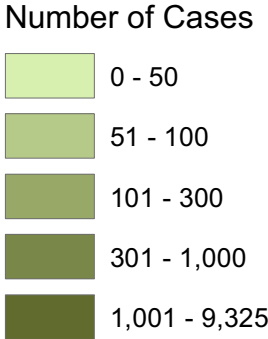


HIV CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF FEBRUARY 29, 2008

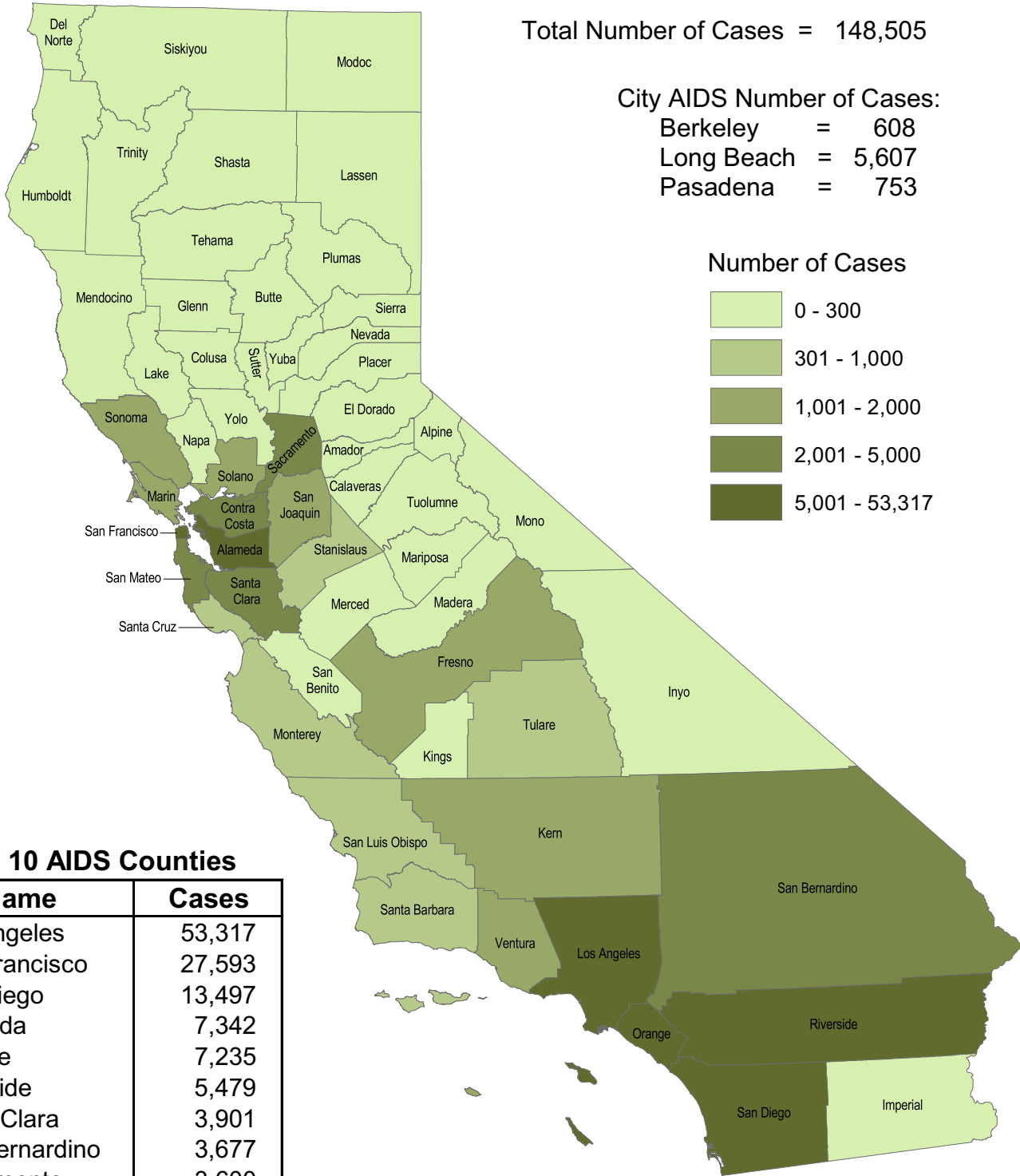

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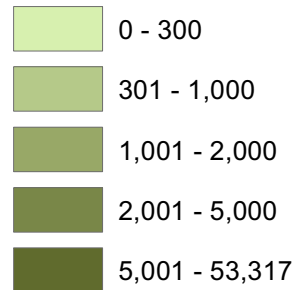

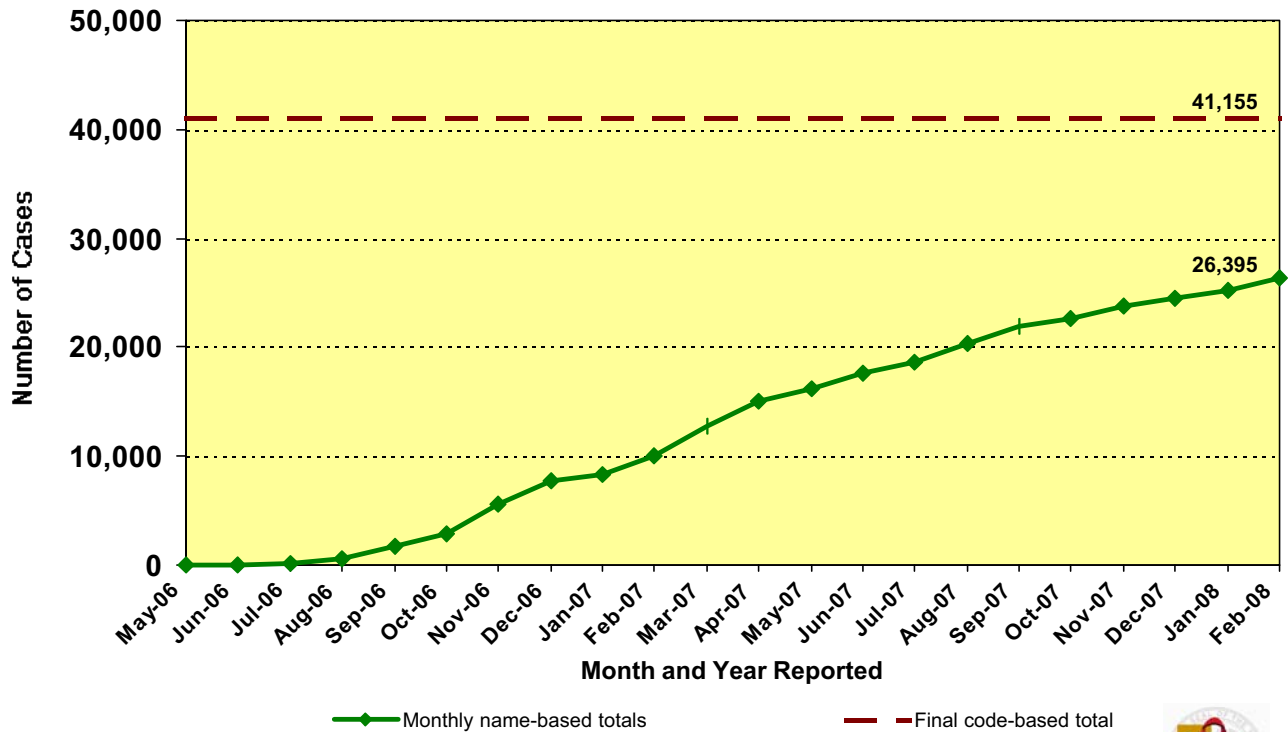
