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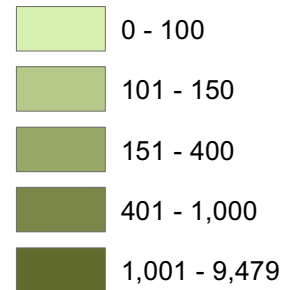
HIV CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF MARCH 31, 2008

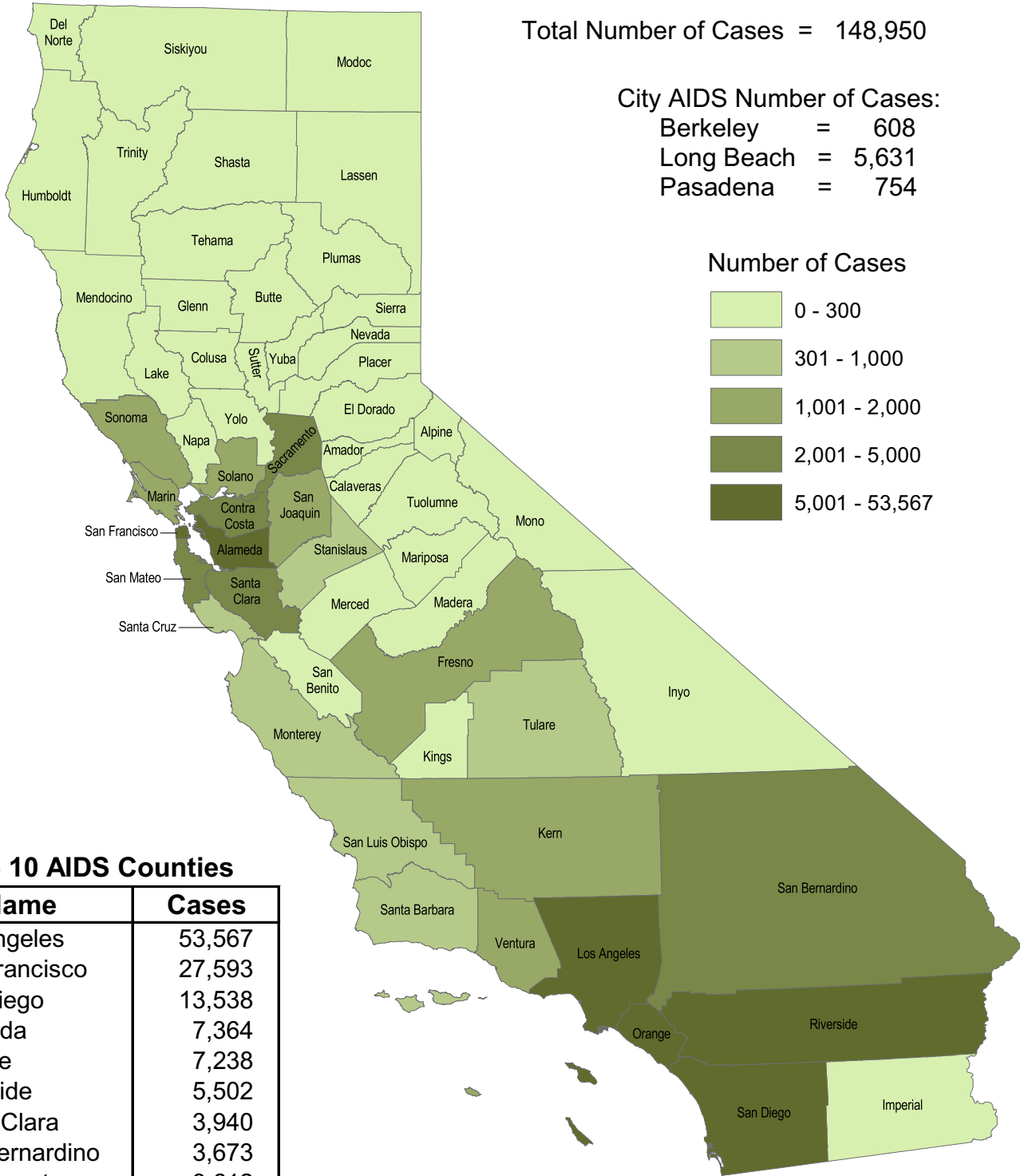

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AIDS CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF MARCH 31, 2008



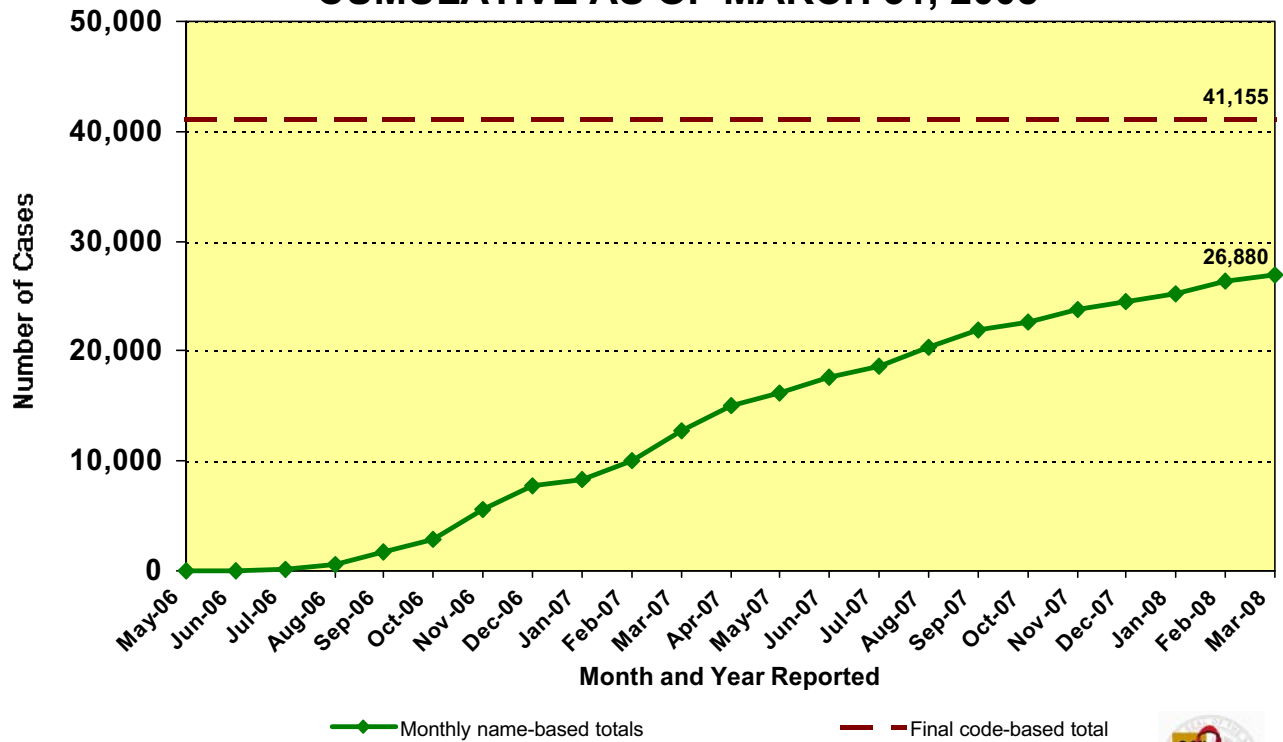
