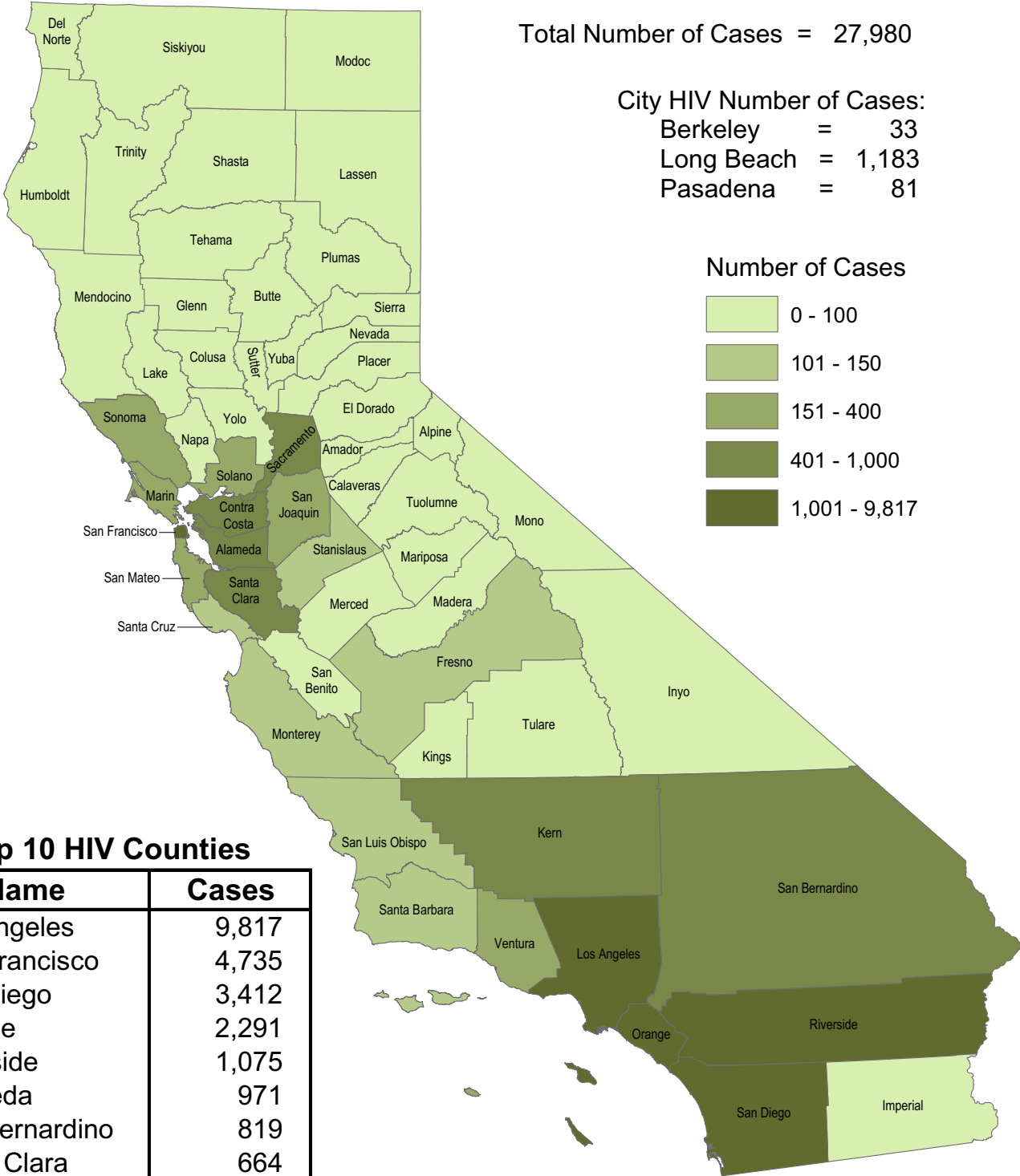

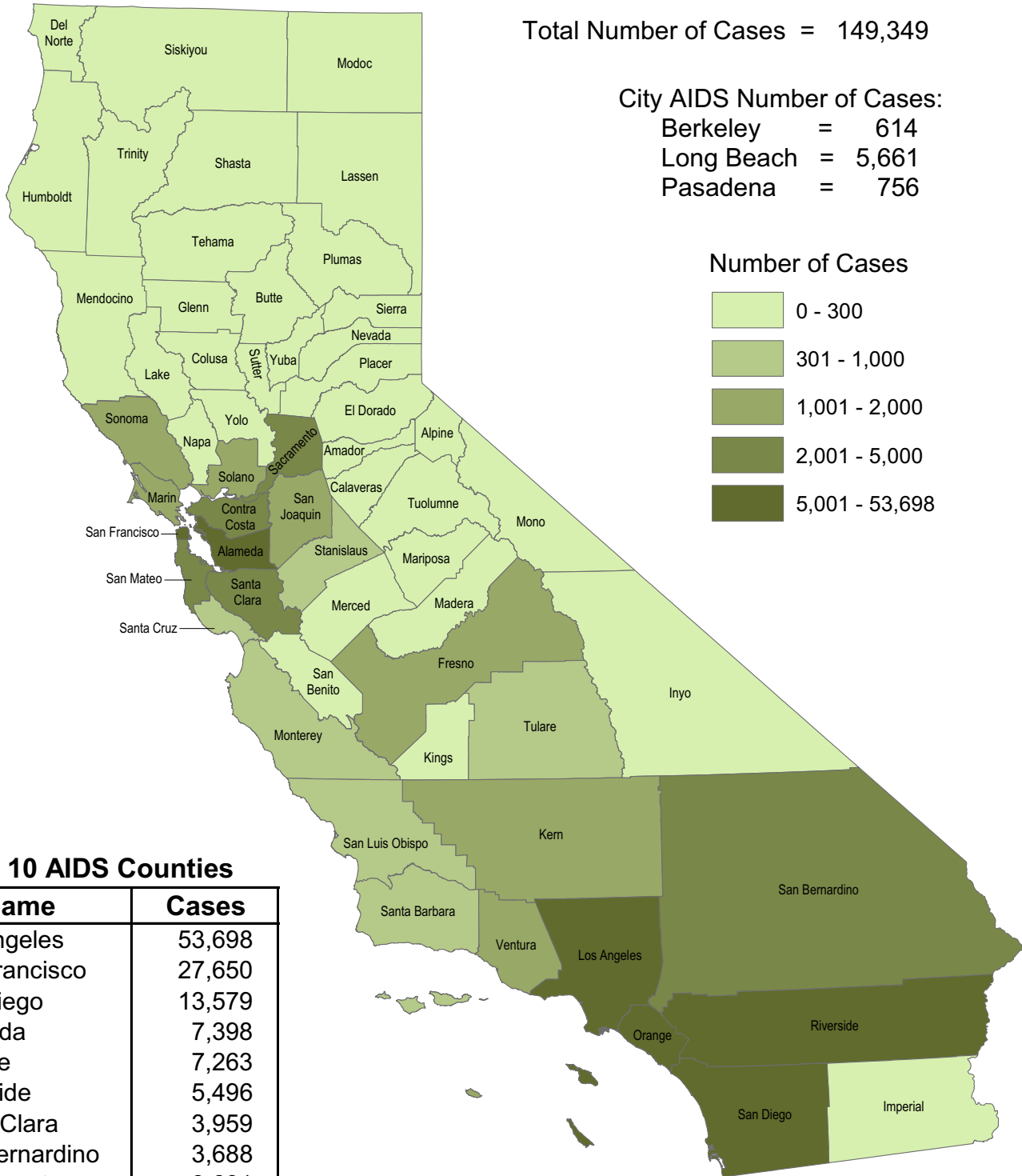

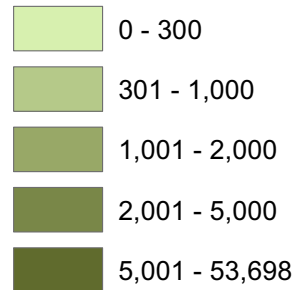
AIDS CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF APRIL 30, 2008

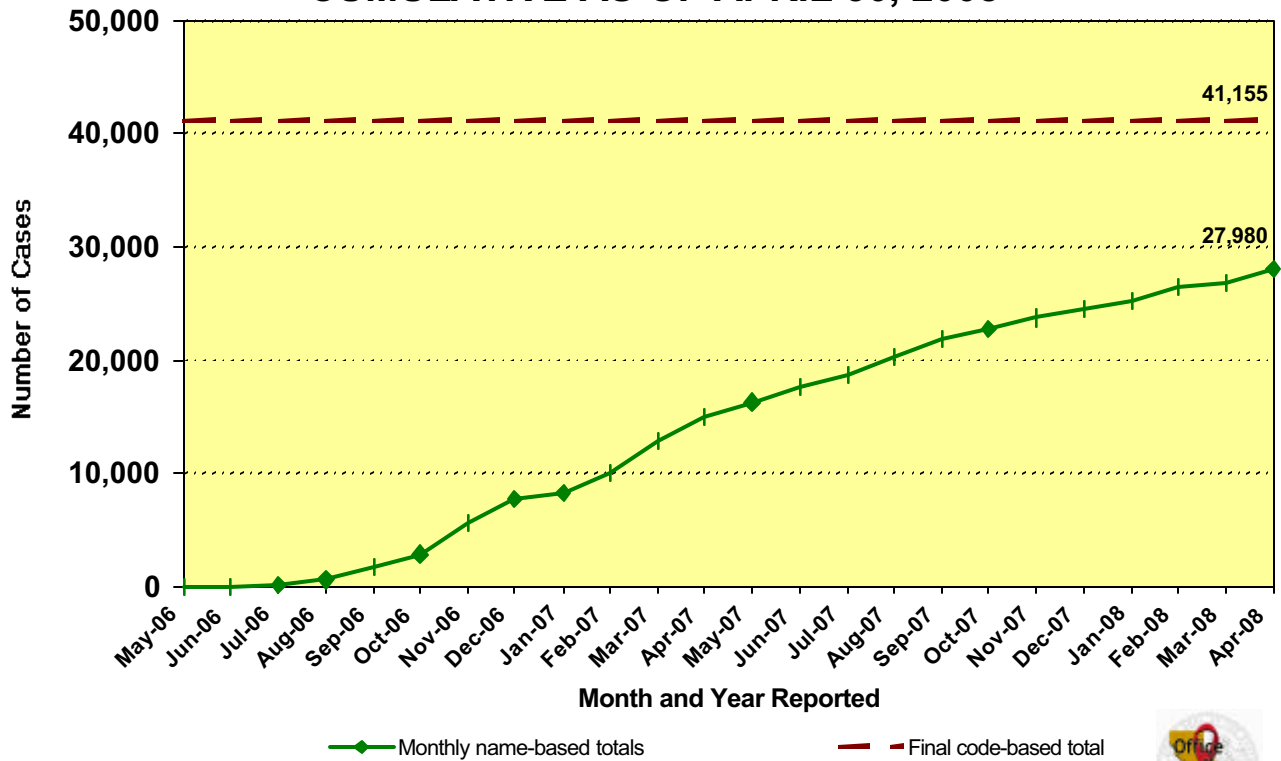
