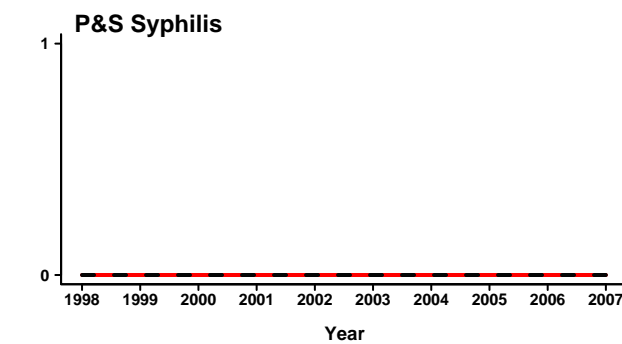
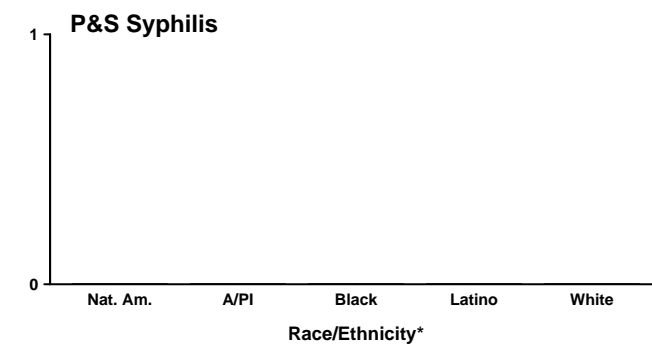
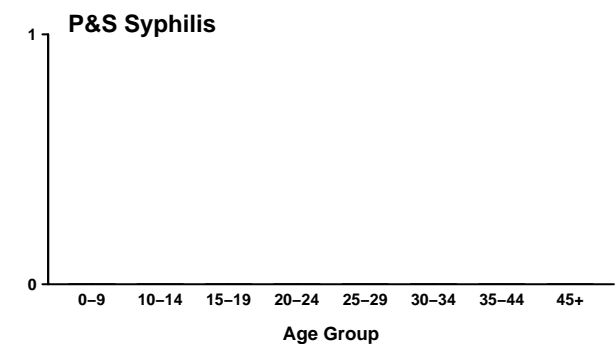
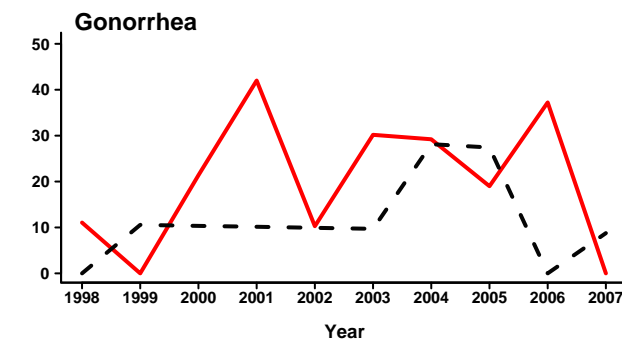
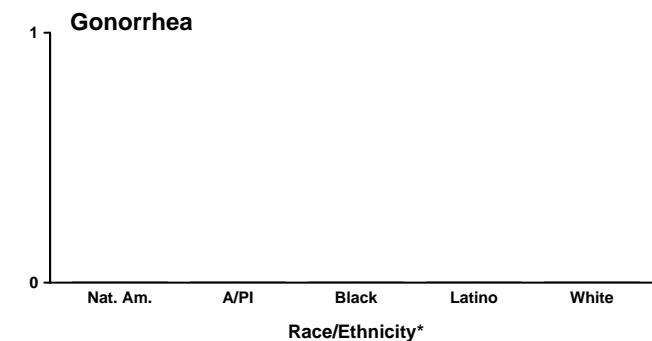
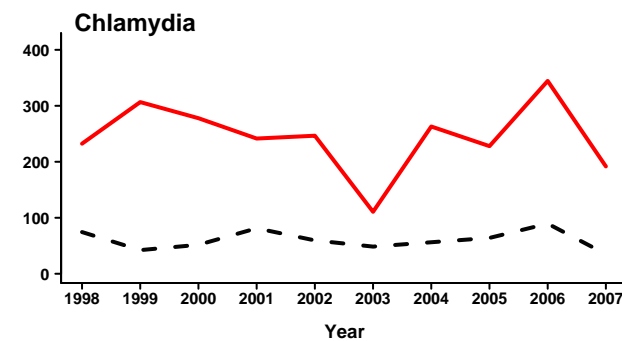
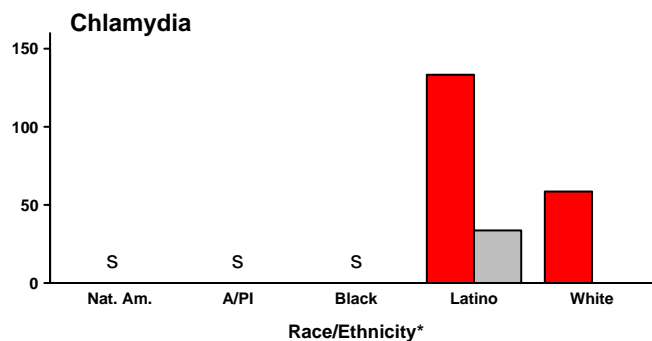
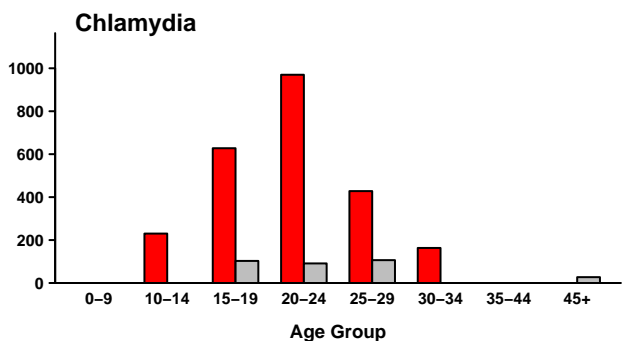


# Colusa County – Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, and P&S Syphilis Rates by Age Group (2007), Race/Ethnicity (2007), and Year
