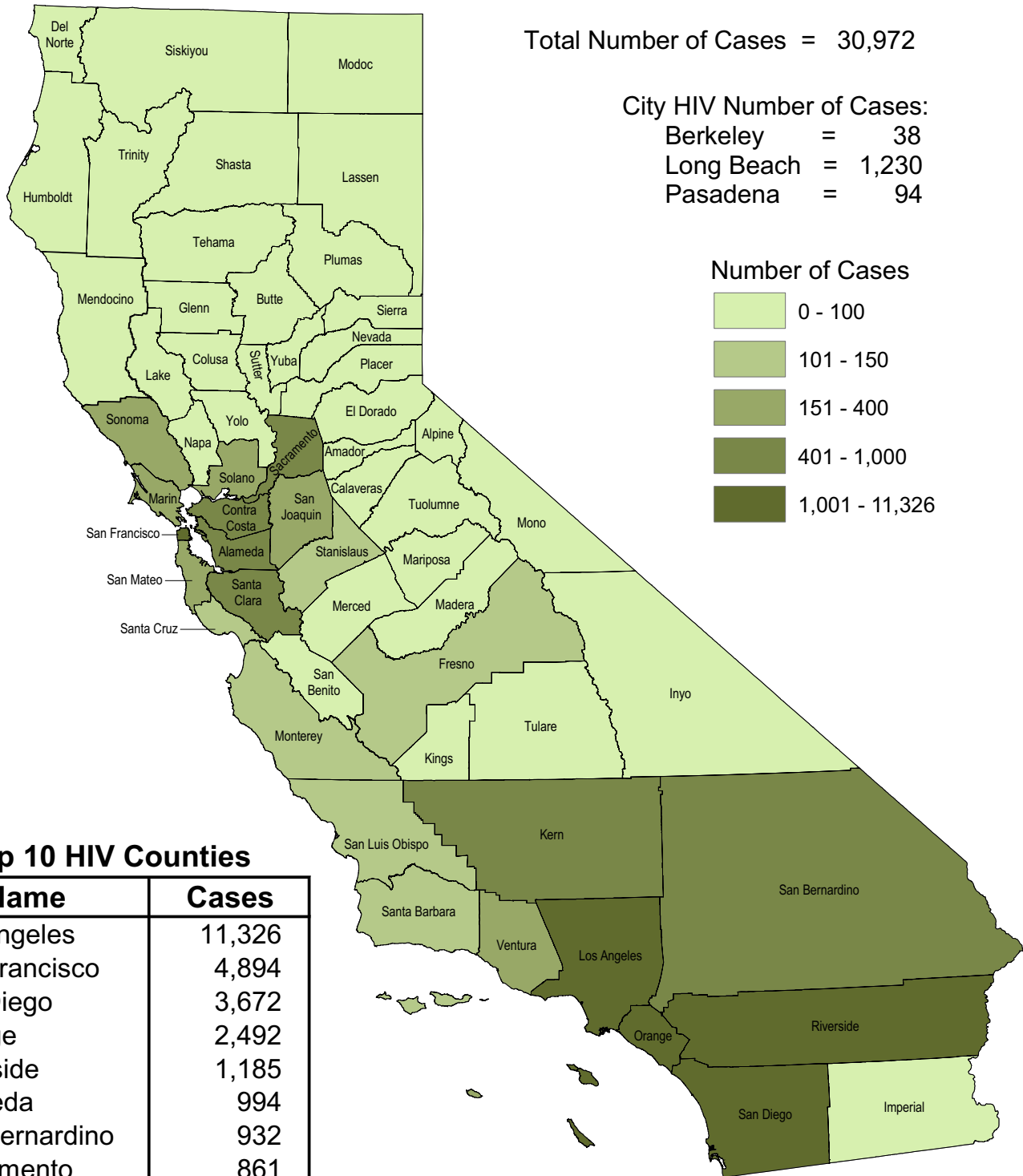

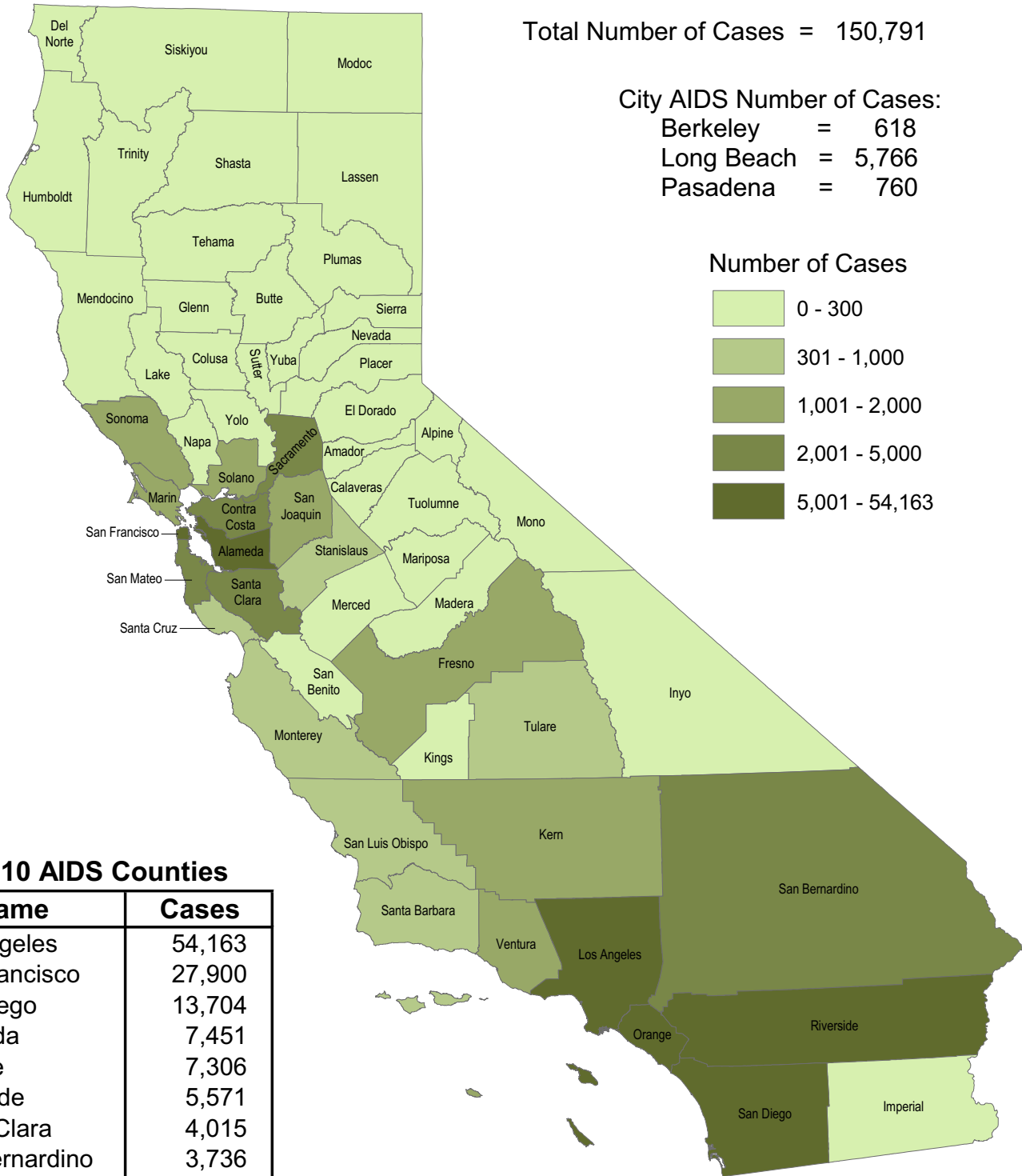

 Pasadena = 760



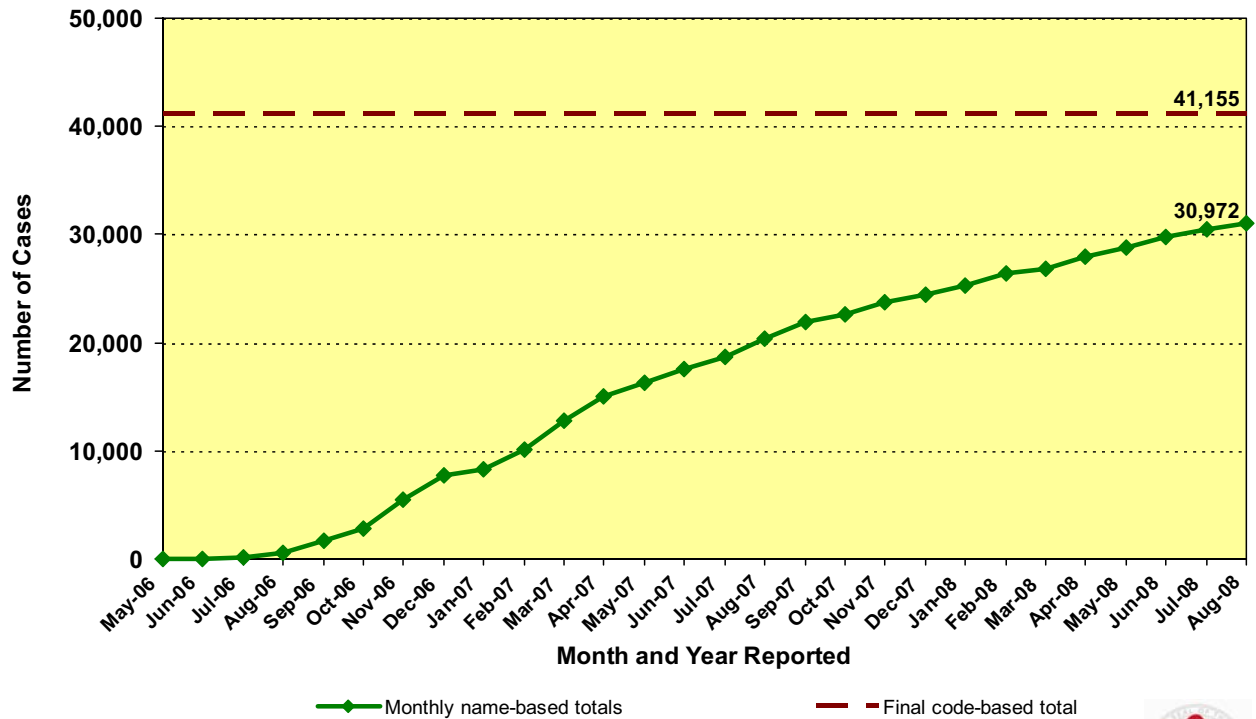
